Minnesota

STATUS: Public


TYPE: Historic, District

HISTORY: Hader was a stop on the St. Paul to Dubuque stage line and developed into a community of businesses, post office, a school and houses. The organized pioneer town survived well into the 1900's but eventually dwindled into a small rural community.
