STATUS: Public

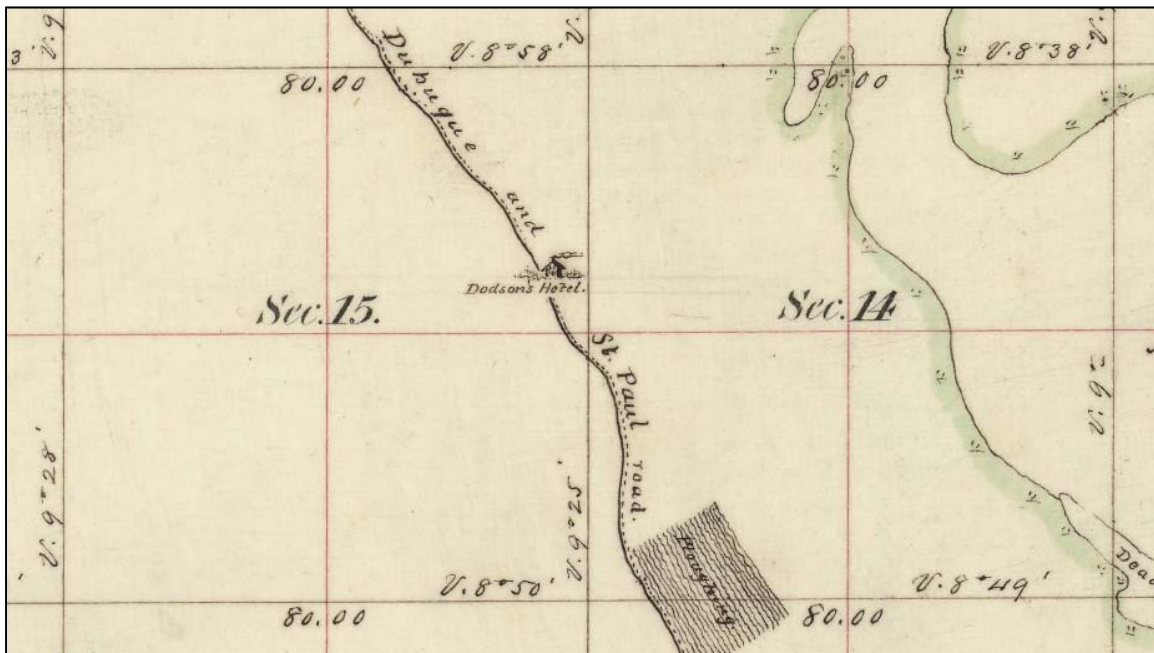
TYPE: Historic, District

HISTORY: Poplar Grove was one of the first post offices, 1855, in Goodhue County during the pioneer era. Originally operated out of Dodson's Hotel on the St. Paul to Dubuque stage route, it then moved accordingly with the new postmasters.
