STATUS: Public

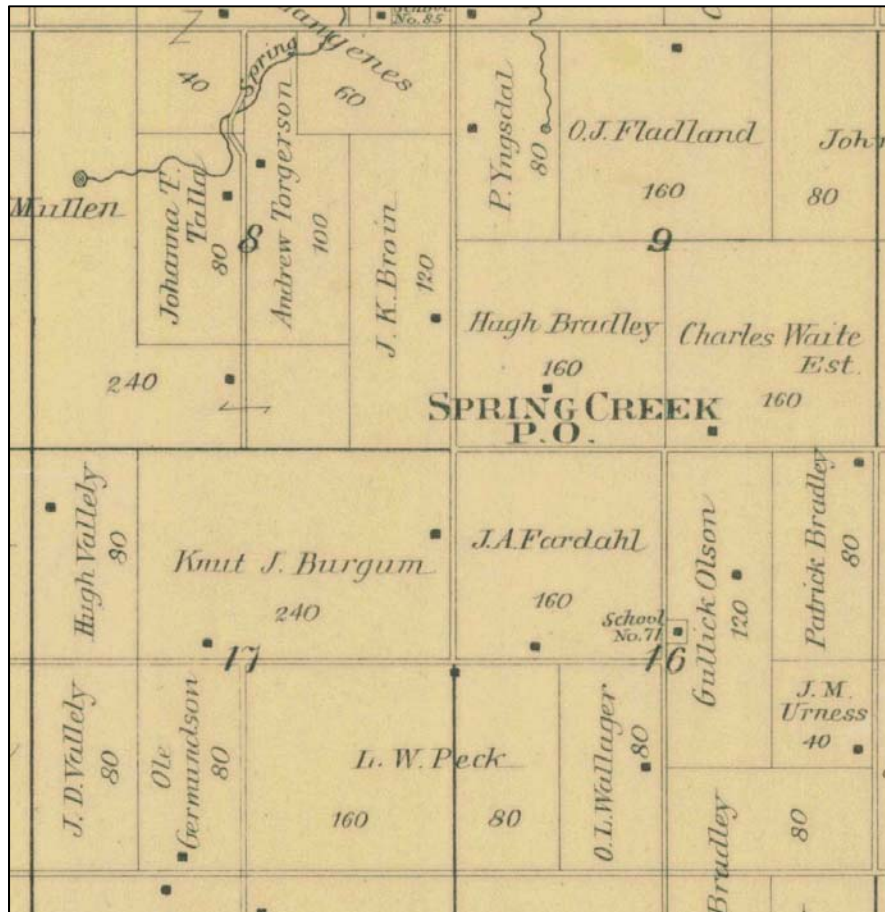
TYPE: Historic, District

HISTORY: Spring Creek post office opened in 1860 and lasted for 42 years. The post office was in farmhouses of the postmasters and moved around the countryside in Cherry Grove Township through the years. Spring Creek post office was truly rural, covering a large area. Spring Creek never was a community, just of rural post office in a farmhouse.
