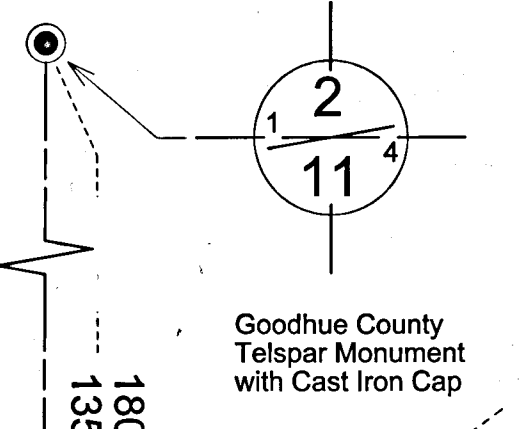
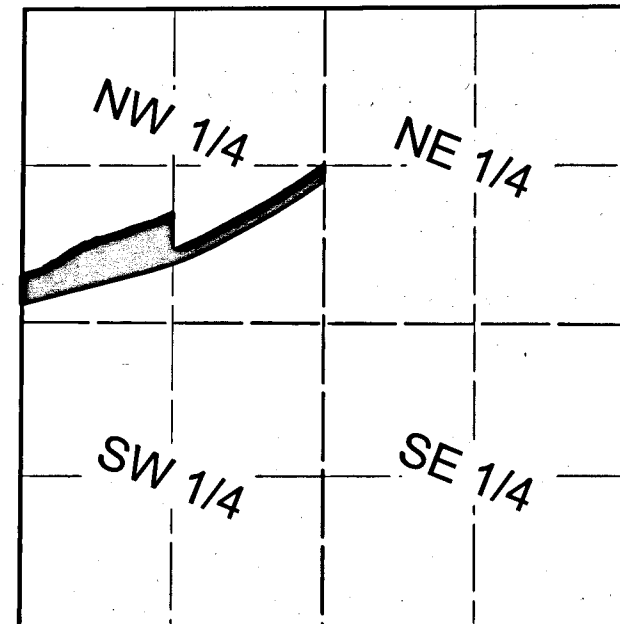


CANNON VALLEY TRAIL PLAT NO. 7

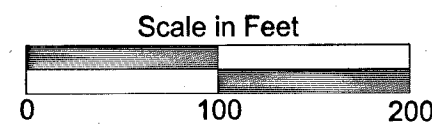


VICINITY MAP

Parcel 1 Existing Legal Description of Record (Document No. 299420):

A strip of land 100 feet in width extending over and across the South Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 11, Township 112 North, Range 17 West, Goodhue County, Minnesota; said strip of land being 50 feet in width on each side of the center line of the main track (now removed) of the Minnesota Central Railroad Company (later the Wisconsin, Minnesota and Pacific Railroad Company, the Chicago Great Western Railway Company, and the Chicago and North Western Transportation Company), as main track center line was originally located and established over and across said Section 11.

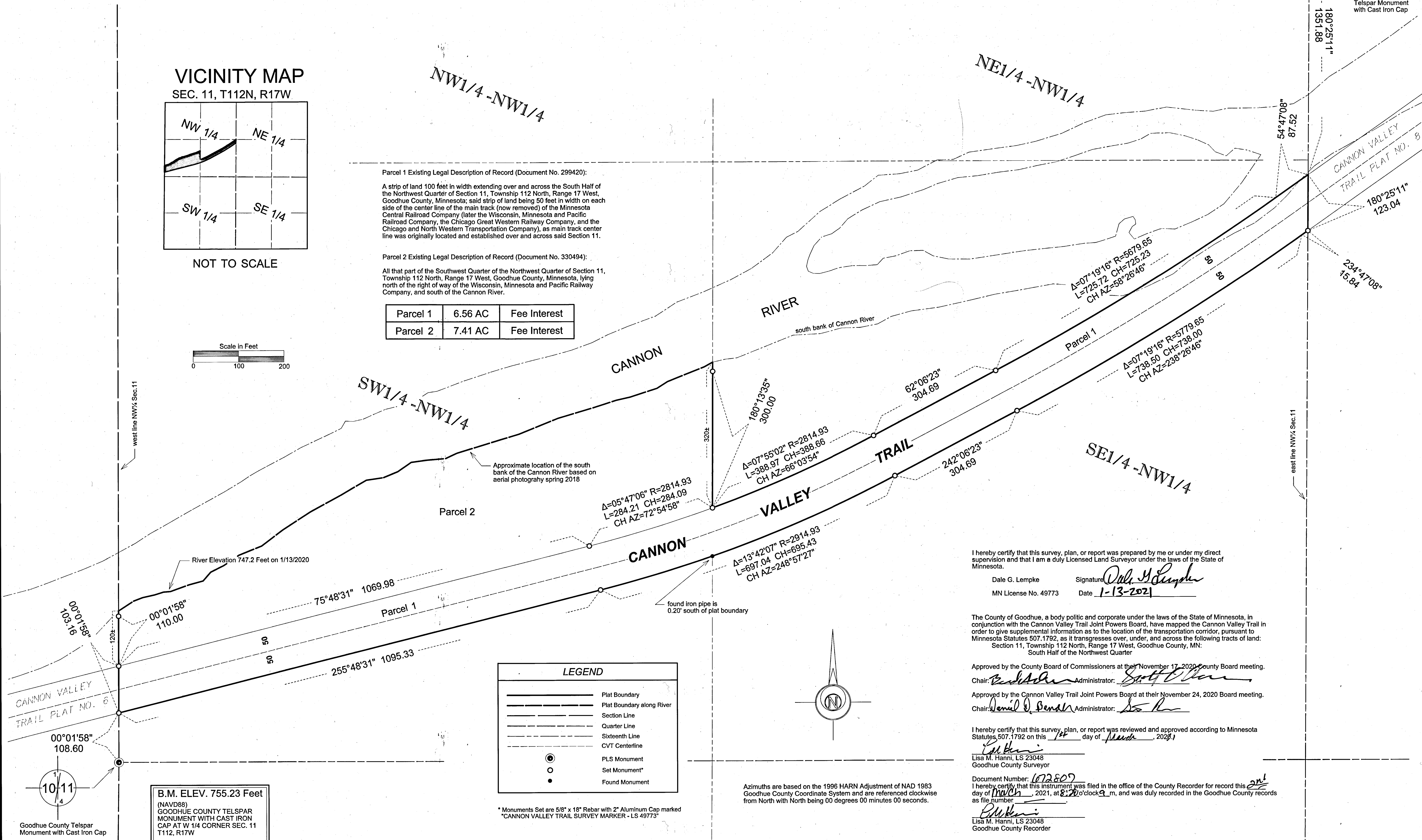
Parcel 2 Existing Legal Description of Record (Document No. 330494):

All that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 11, Township 112 North, Range 17 West, Goodhue County, Minnesota, lying north of the right of way of the Wisconsin, Minnesota and Pacific Railway Company, and south of the Cannon River.
