

WACOUTA TOWNSHIP ROADS

TOWNSHIP RESOLUTION

At a town board meeting of Wacouta Township in Goodhue County, Minnesota held on 10TH day of JUNE, 1985 at 7:00 o'clock P.m. at the town hall in said township, Supervisor ROESTER, introduced and moved the adoption of the following Resolution, which was seconded by Supervisor SCHUELLER, and unanimously adopted by the town board of supervisors:

WHEREAS, Wacouta Township in Goodhue County, Minnesota contains a number of township roads, and

WHEREAS, Nearly all of the township roads have been established by use and/or prescription or by dedication and there may or may not be a record of said roads recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of Goodhue County, Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, The township board of supervisors has determined it to be in the best interest of the township, the public and all parties concerned to determine and record the center line location of said duly established town roads, and

WHEREAS, The town board has made an inventory of the town roads contained in Wacouta Township, and

WHEREAS, The town board held a public hearing on the proposal on the 10TH day of JUNE, 1985 at 7:00 o'clock P.m. and that notice of said hearing was provided according to law,

WHEREAS, the recording of such inventory will resolve many of the numerous questions which have previously arisen regarding the town roads, and

WHEREAS, the recording of said inventory will be beneficial in establishing and maintaining the integrity of said town roads and informing present and future residents of same;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the town roads shown and described herein are deemed to be and are established as town roads of the Town of Wacouta as set out in Exhibit "A".

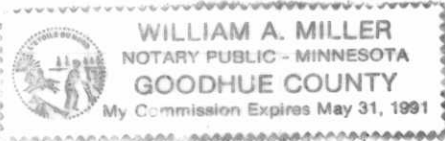
AFFIDAVIT OF USE
