

Instrument of Dedication

Know all men by these presents, that we, Orran J. Bremer and Katherine Bremer, his wife; the owners in fee-simple of the following described real estate situated in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 21, Township III North, Range 15 West in the Village of Goodhue in County of Goodhue, State of Minnesota, to-wit:

Beginning on the East line of Fifth Street distant 66 feet South of the Southwest corner of Block 7 of Davis Second Addition to the Village of Goodhue, according to the plat thereof now on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said County; thence run South along said East line of Fifth Street for 292 feet; thence East 120 feet; thence North 292 feet; thence West 120 feet to Place of Beginning.

Do hereby declare that we have caused said premises to be surveyed and platted and monuments fixed as designated on plat by Albert E. Rhame, County Surveyor of Goodhue County, in the manner shown on the within plat, and we do hereby designate and name the same as "Bremer's Addition" to the Village of Goodhue, and do further declare that we are the owners in fee-simple of the said real estate and that the said premises are free from all incumbrances, and we hereby dedicate to the Public use forever, the Streets and Alleys hereon designated to be used, occupied and enjoyed as such Streets and Alleys.
