Know all men by these presents: That we, owners of the following described real estate in the City of Red Wing, County of Goodhue and State of Minnesota, to wit: All that part of Government Lots 1 and 5 in Section 31, Township 113 North, Range 14 West, described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the north line of said Government Lot 5 with the east line of Glen View Addition; thence east 414 feet; thence south 200 feet; thence west 204 feet; thence southwesterly from a true North and South line, on a 6° curve, for 650 feet more or less, to its intersection with the east line of Glen View Addition at the southeasterly line of Audrey Avenue as already platted; thence north along the east line of Glen View Addition 1813 feet to the Place of Beginning.
