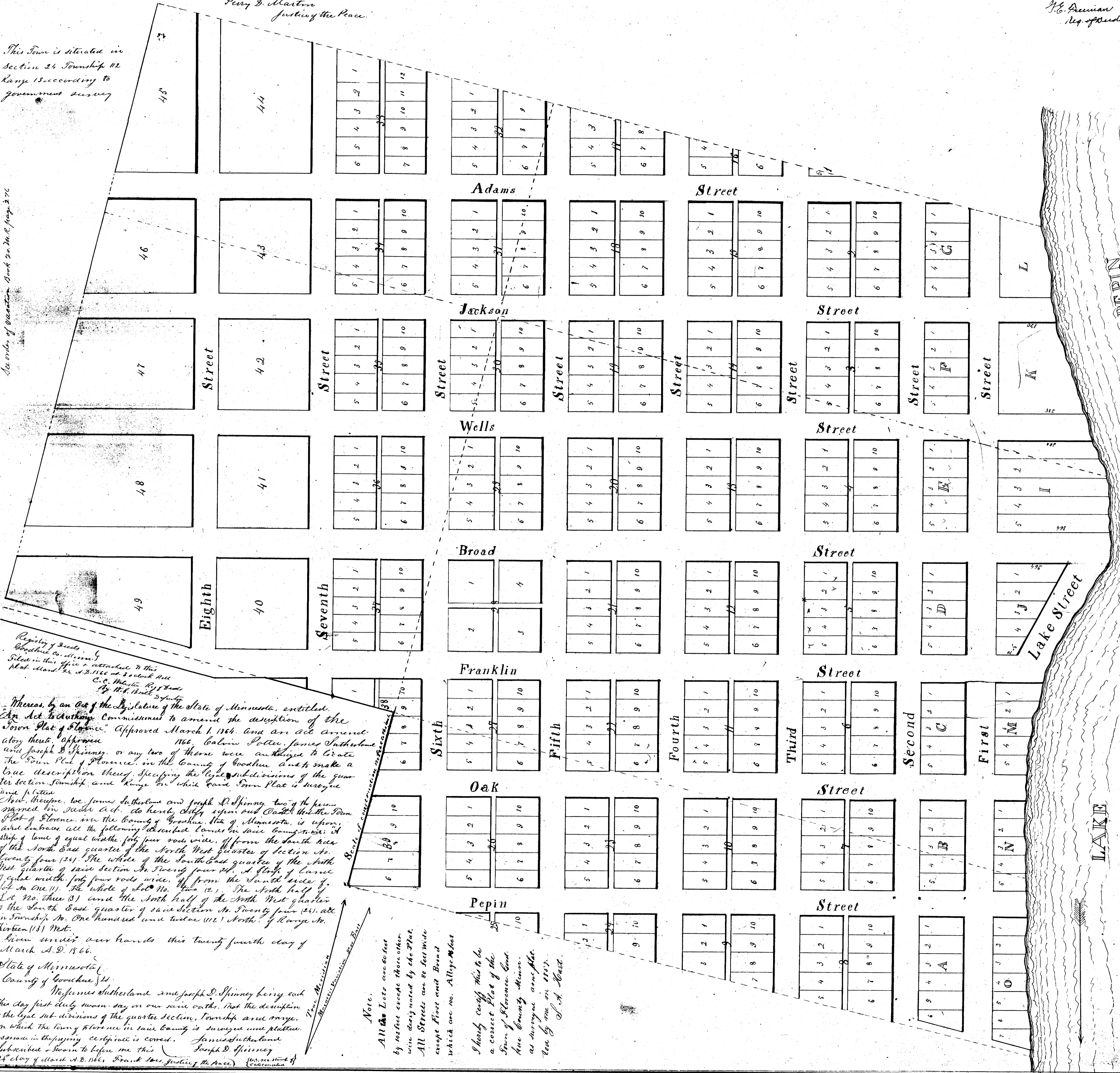

Whereas, by an Act of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota, entitled, "An Act to Authorize Commissioners to amend the description of the Town Plat of Florence," Approved March 1, 1864, and an Act amendatory thereto, approved 1866, Calvin Potter, James Sutherland and Joseph D. Spinney, or any two of them were authorized to locate the Town Plat of Florence, in the County of Goodhue, and to make a true description thereof, specifying the legal subdivisions of the quarter section Township, and Range on which said Town Plat is surveyed and situate

Now, therefore, we James Sutherland and Joseph D. Spinney, two of the persons named in said Act, do hereby certify again and confirm that the Town Plat of Florence, in the County of Goodhue, State of Minnesota, is upon and embraces all the following described lands in said County, to-wit: A strip of land of equal width, forty-four rods wide, off from the south side of the North East quarter of the North West quarter of section No. twenty-four (24), the whole of the South East quarter of the North West quarter of said section No. twenty-four (24), a strip of land of equal width, forty-four rods wide, off from the south side of Lot No. one (1), the whole of Lot No. two (2), the North half of Lot No. three (3) and the North half of the North West quarter of the South East quarter of said section No. twenty-four (24), all in Township No. One hundred and twelve (112) North, of Range No. Thirteen (13) West.

Given under our hands this twenty-fourth day of March A.D. 1866.
