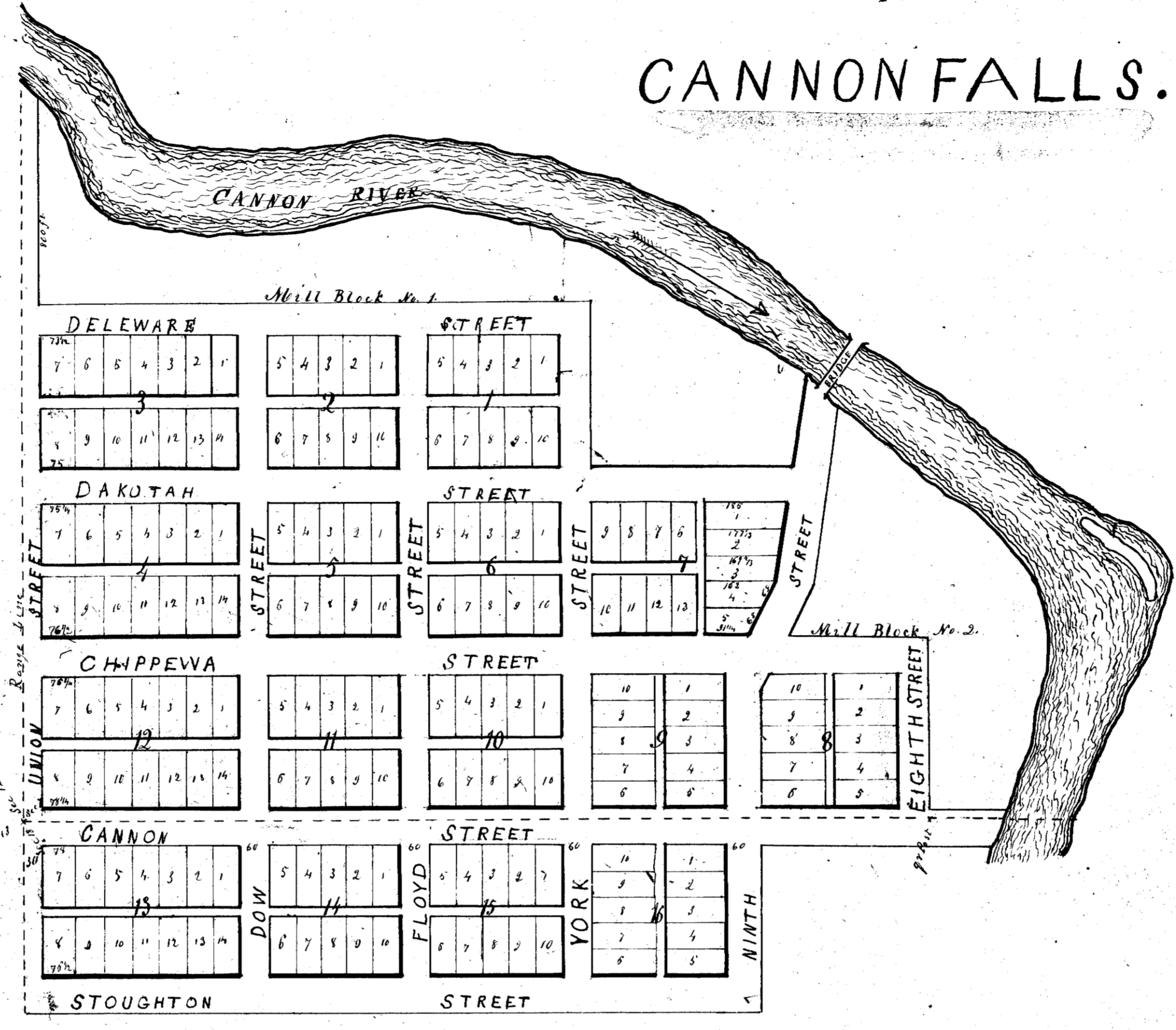

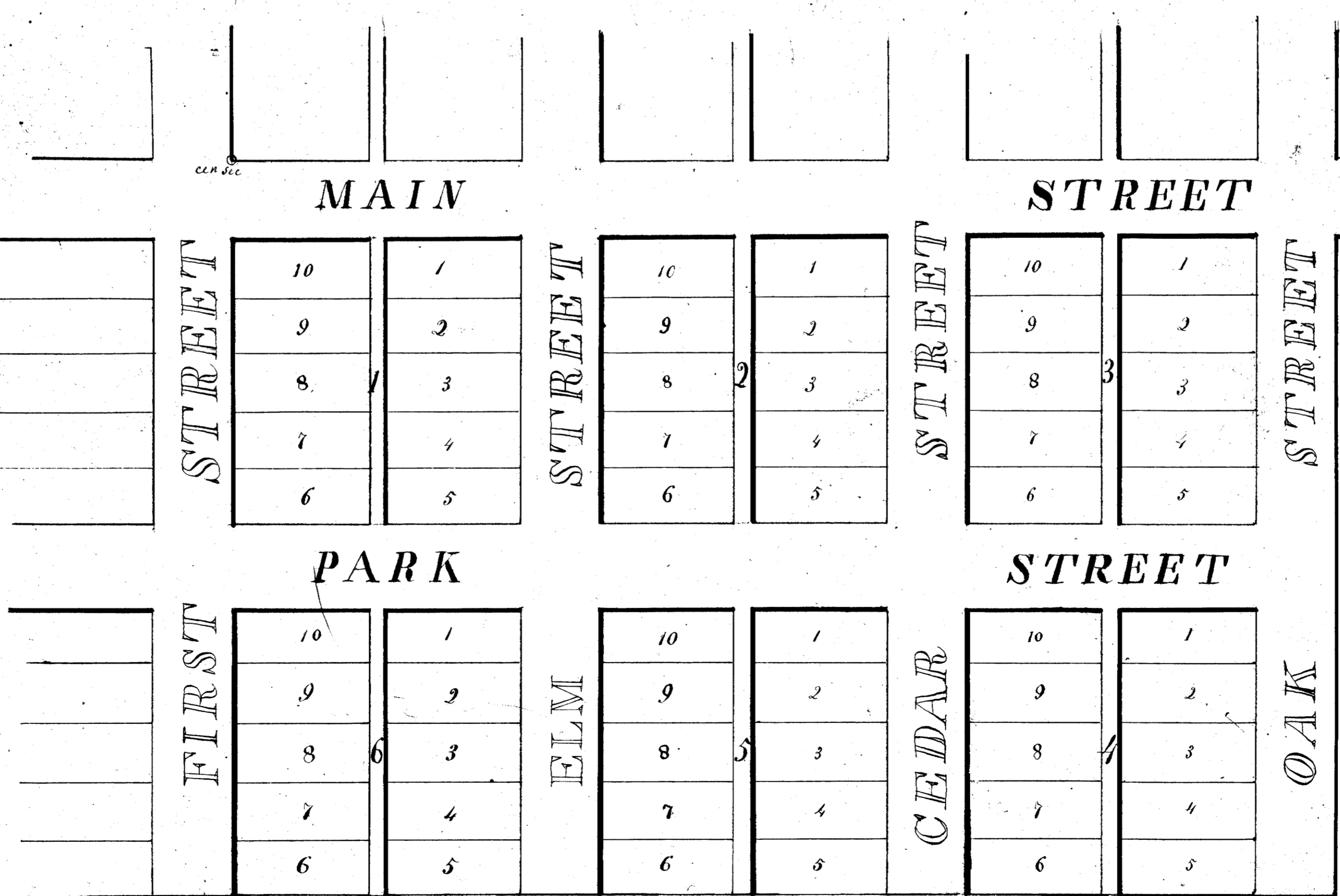

Point Lookout is situated in Township 112 North of Range 17 West and occupies the South West corner of the South East quarter of Section 18 and is bounded from a stone at the center of the section on the North East corner of Main's First Street at their intersection. In presence of *James O. Saw* C.E. Secretary of Minnesota, County of Goodhue. Be it known that on this 28th day of April A.D. 1857 personally came before me *James O.
