SWEENEY'S ADDITION



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Boundaries & Description.
Commencing at the corner of Section 30, 32d & 3rd to Gary Line between Range 14 1/2 West of 5th Principal Meridian and running thence West along the Section line between Sections 33 & 34 1/2 m. or there 1.2 m. with a variation of 15' E., 33 1/2 ft. for a street at the edge of the Bay, thence in an easterly direction along the edge of the Bay 110 feet, more or less to the West side of Jefferson Street in Sweeney's addition to Red Wing, thence 8.187 m. 180 feet to the south side of 6th Street, thence 8.912 m. along the side of 6th Street 180 feet to the West side of Washington Street, thence 8.187 m. along the side of Washington Street, 180 feet to the south side of 6th Street, thence 1.187 m. along 6th Street, 180 feet to the West side of Cedar Street, thence 8.117 m. along Cedar Street, 180 feet to the Section line between Sections 30 & 31, thence West along said Section line 221 1/2 feet to the point of beginning.

Main Street is 66 feet wide and runs N. 85° W. 5th Street is 10 feet wide and with its parallel streets runs N. 77 1/2 W. with a variation of 15'. All other streets are each 66 feet wide. Regular Blocks are 58 feet deep by 300 wide. Regular lots are 60 feet front by 15 1/2 ft. deep. All other blocks and lots in any of the corners, some marked upon this plan, all of which carry the corner or Surveyed by me for W. W. Sweeney,
