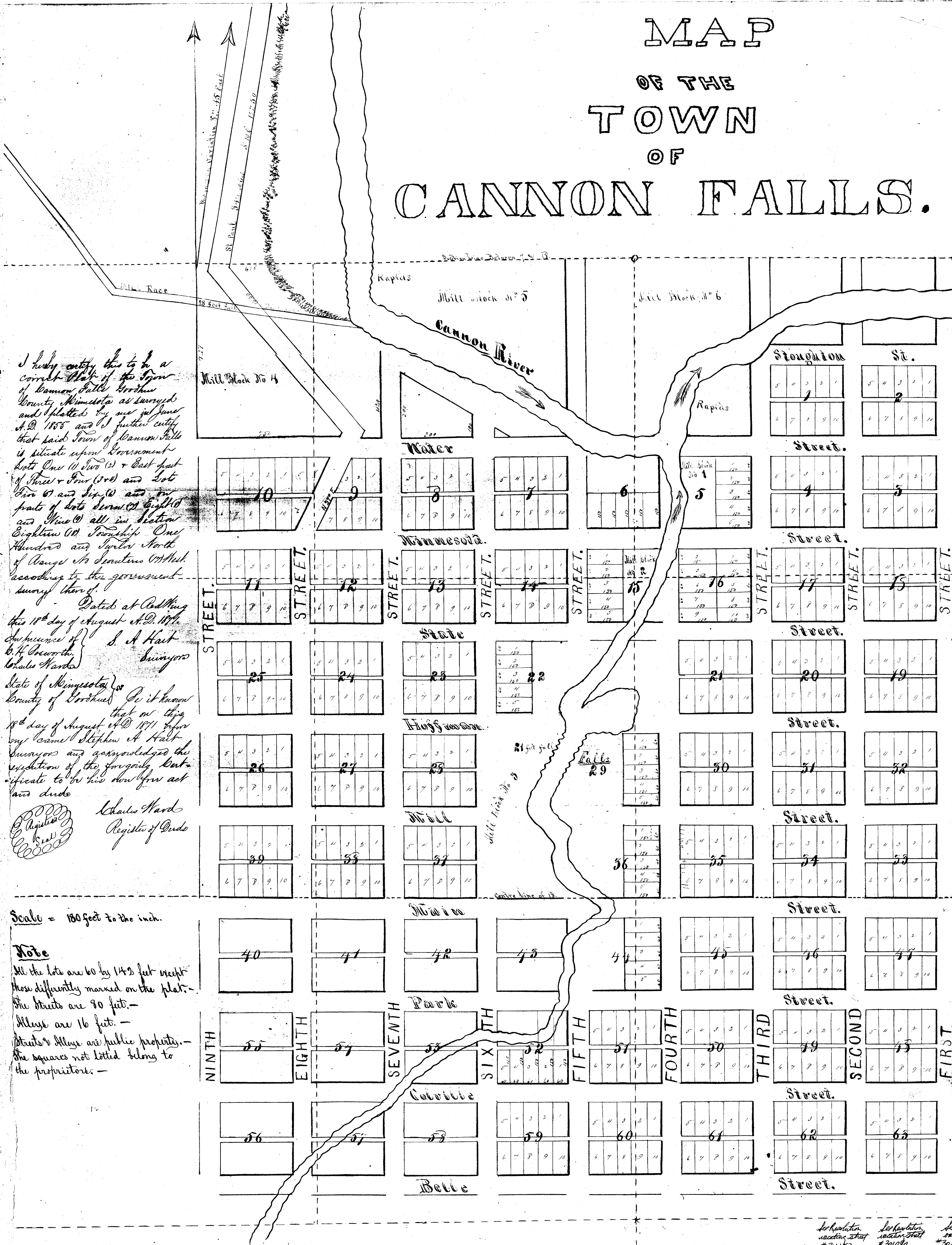


MAP OF THE TOWN OF CANNON FALLS.
