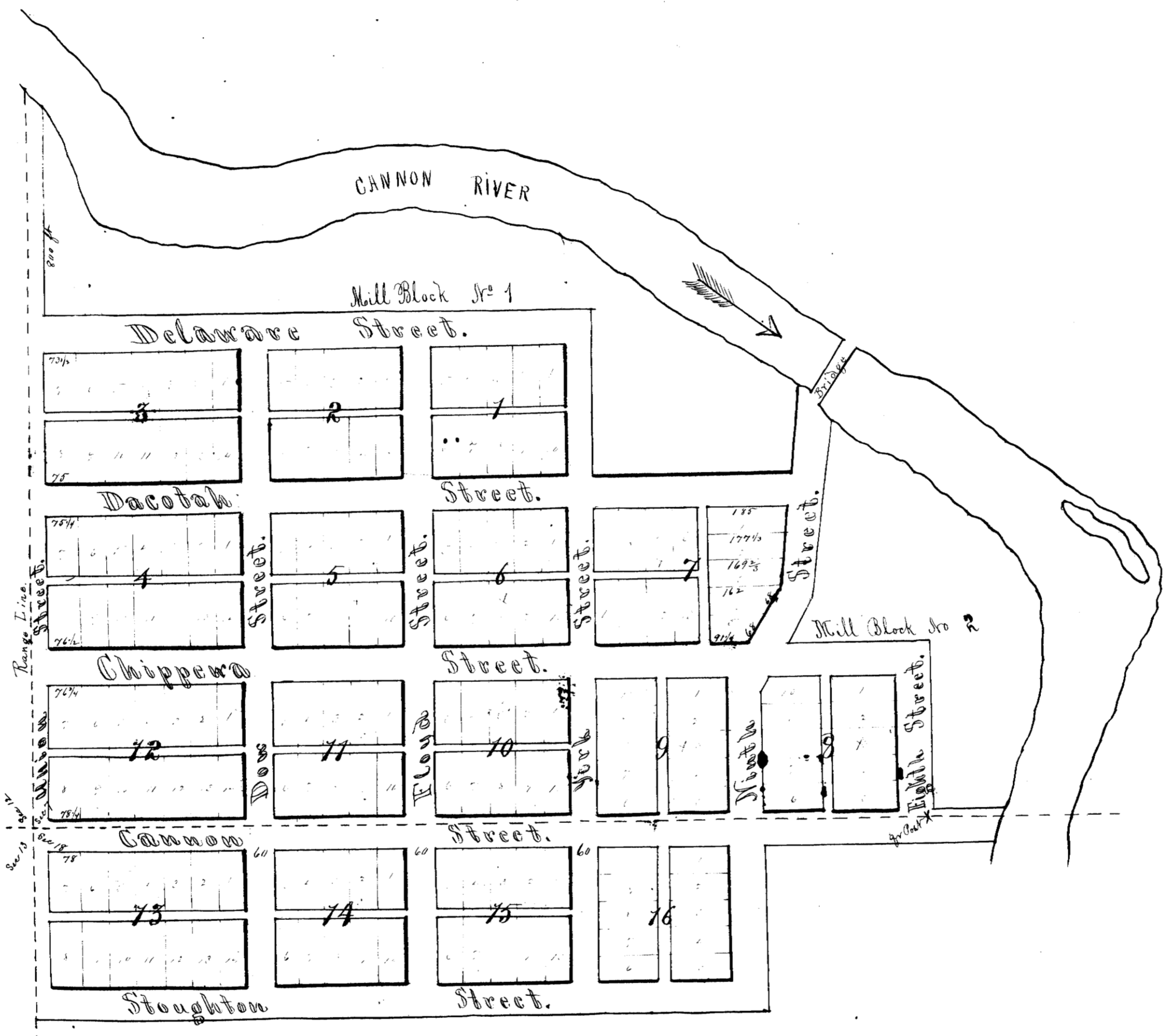


CANNON FALLS ADDITION.
