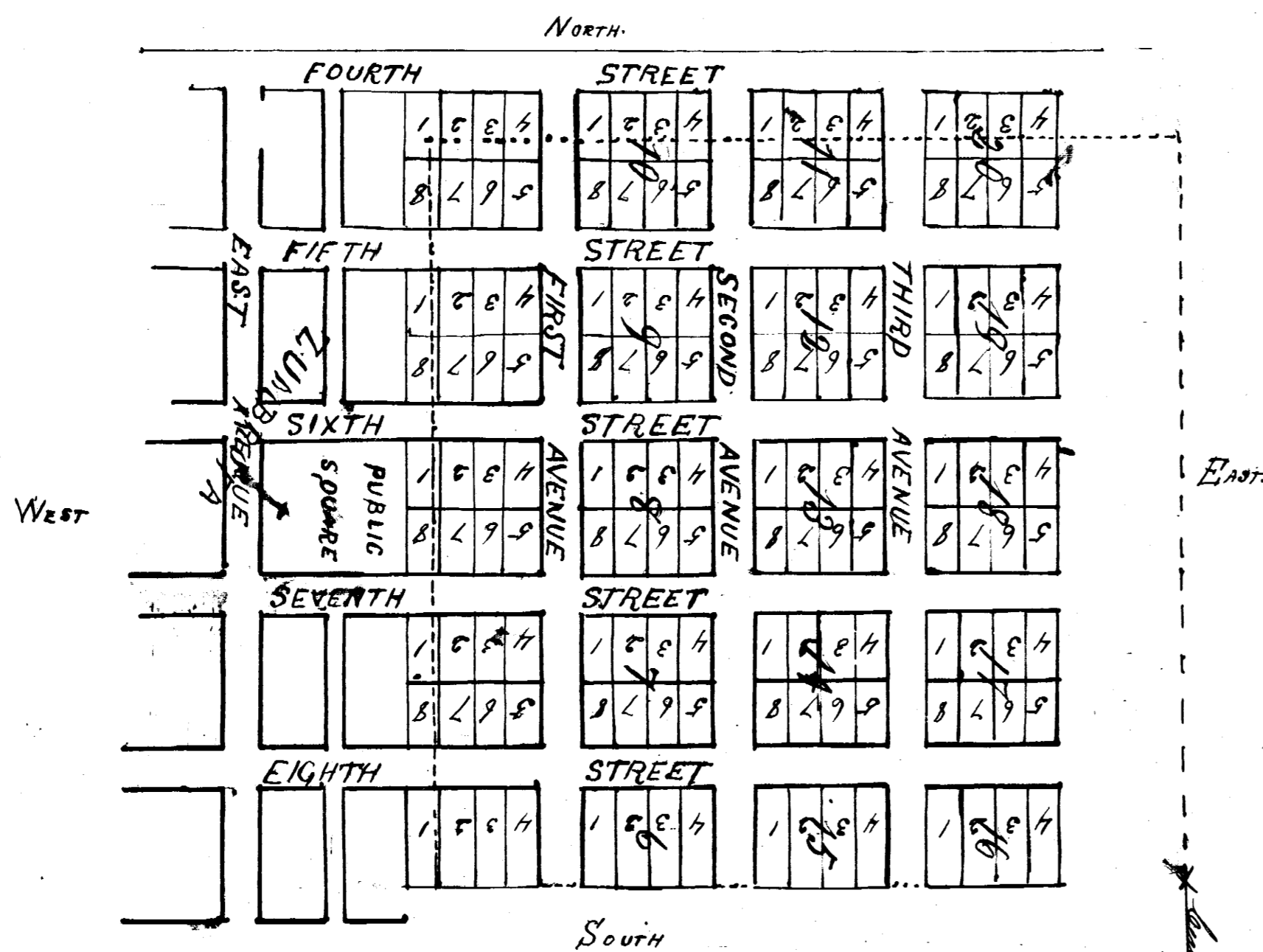

It is hereby certified that this addition to the town of Zumbrota is situated and lying in the South East Quarter (SE) of the South West Quarter of Section 34 (SW) Township one hundred and two (102) Range 107 West (107) and 108 West (108) on the North side (East) side and four (4) feet wide and a strip on the West side adjoining the village plat of Zumbrota 1/2 (1/2) feet wide at the South end and full 20 (20) feet wide at the North and the lots are 100 (100) feet wide by one hundred and twenty (120) feet long except the South line of blocks in which the lots are 100 (100) feet wide by one hundred and twenty (120) feet long. The streets and avenues are 66 (66) feet wide and 100 (100) feet long and dedicate the said streets and avenues for public use.
