This is to certify that this Addition to the town of Zumbrota is situated and lying
in the North East quarter of the North West quarter of Section third, one Town
110 Range 15 containing about 13 acres, and is bounded on the North by land
of D. C. Stearns and the Rochester and Northern Rail Road. On the East by the quar-
ter line of said quarter section and land of D. W. Blake. On the South by land
of D. W. Blake and Stearns Addition to Zumbrota and on the West by Blocks
6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 in the town of Zumbrota. And 2^d, 3^d, 4th Streets by the town of
Zumbrota as extended in this Addition. Block No. 1, is 194 feet by 240 feet,
the lots in Block 2, are 85 ft. by 120, in Block 3, 60 ft. by 130 in Blocks 4 & 5,
66 ft. by 130, in Blocks 6, 7, 104 ft. by 132, in Block 8, 60 ft. by 120, except lots
1, and 18, are 66 ft. by 120. Streets and Avenues are 66 feet wide excepting
125 feet in length at the West end of 2^d Street it is two rods wide, and hereby
dedicate and donate the said Streets and Avenues for public use.
