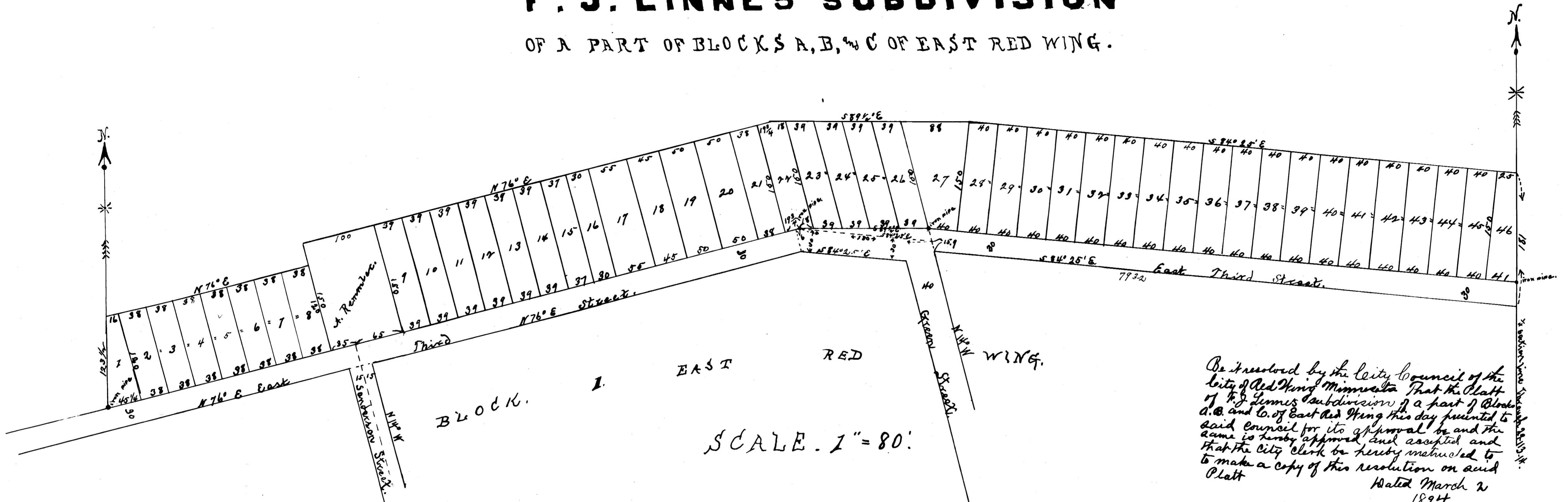


F. J. LINNE'S SUBDIVISION

OF A PART OF BLOCKS A, B, & C OF EAST RED WING.



Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Red Wing, Minnesota, that the plat of F. J. Linne's subdivision of a part of Blocks A, B, and C of East Red Wing, this day presented to said Council for its approval, be and the same is hereby approved, and accepted, and that the City Clerk be hereby instructed to make a copy of this resolution on said Plat.

Know all men by these presents that the "Twin City Lime and Cement Company", the owners in fee of the following described premises, to-wit: Beginning S 76° 24' 35" E from the intersection of the center line of Sanderson St with the north line of East 2nd St on East Red Wing, running thence S 76° 24' 35" E along the said north line of East 2nd St 311 1/4 ft, thence north 12 3/4 ft, thence N 76° E 282 ft, and thence S 14° E 120 ft to the point of beginning; also beginning N 76° E 65 ft from the intersection of the center line of said Sanderson St with the north line of East Third Street, running thence N 76° E along said line of street 558 1/2 ft, thence S 84° 25' E 180 ft to the east line of Green St, thence on said line to the north line of Block 1 of said East Red Wing, thence on said line S 84° 25' E 773.2 ft, to the N and S Meridian line through section 27-113-14, thence north on said line 181 ft, thence N 84° 25' E 150 ft to the point of beginning; and thence the premises so described to be surveyed and platted into lots by L. R. W. H. County Surveyor for said County, in the manner shown by the plat hereto attached and they do hereby designate and name the same as F. J. Linne's Subdivision and they do hereby dedicate to the public use forever the street shown and appearing as such upon this plat.
