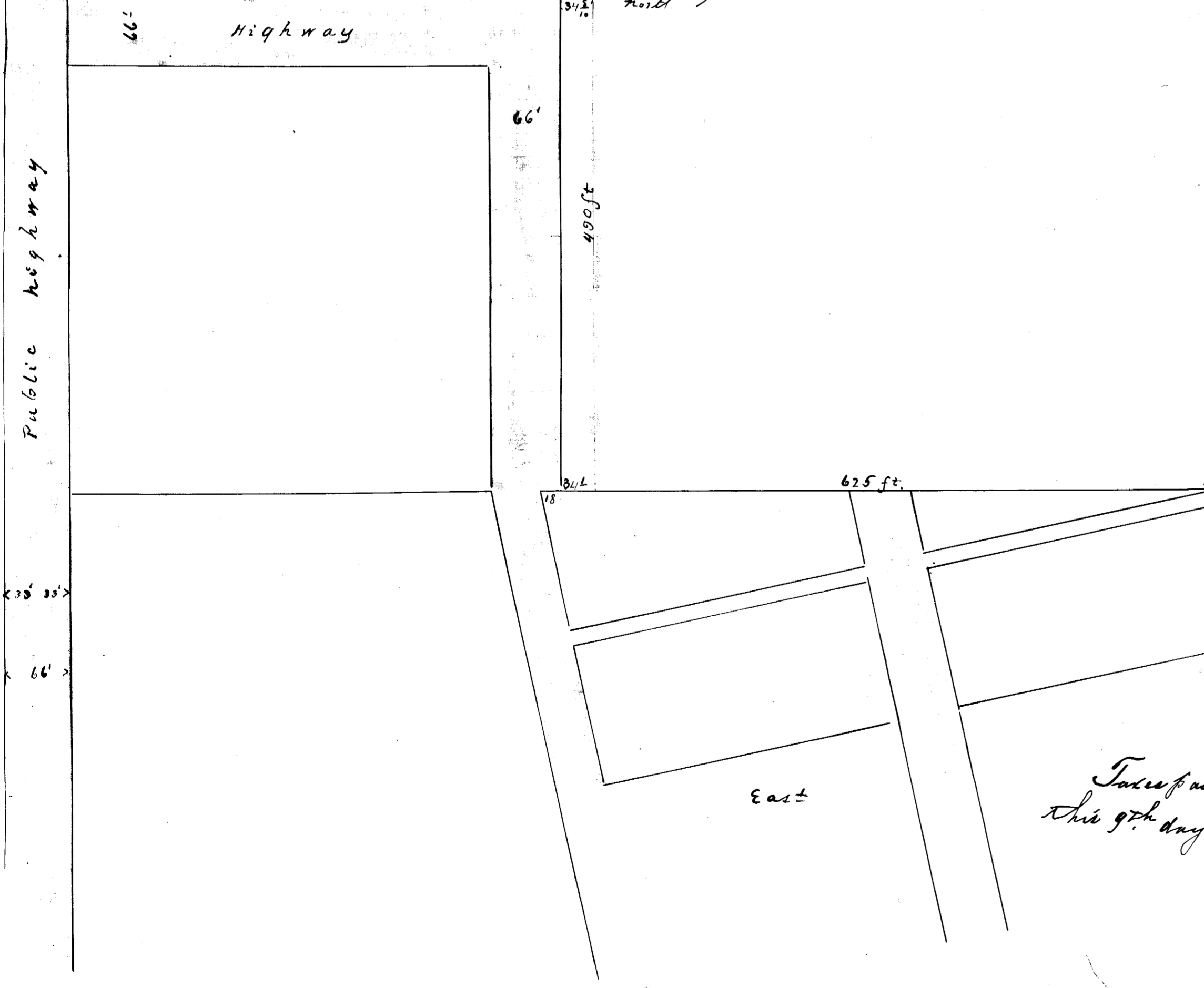

one hundred eleven (111) north of Range fifteen (15) west of the fifth Principal Meridian -
described as follows to-wit: First, after running seven hundred and twenty four (724) feet
west from the south east corner of the said west half of the south west quarter of section twenty
one (21) for place of beginning, thence west sixty six (66) feet, thence north five hundred
sixteen and one half (576 1/2) feet, thence east three hundred (300) feet, thence south
three hundred fourteen (314) feet, thence west two hundred thirty four
(234) feet, thence south two hundred two and one half (202 1/2) feet, to
