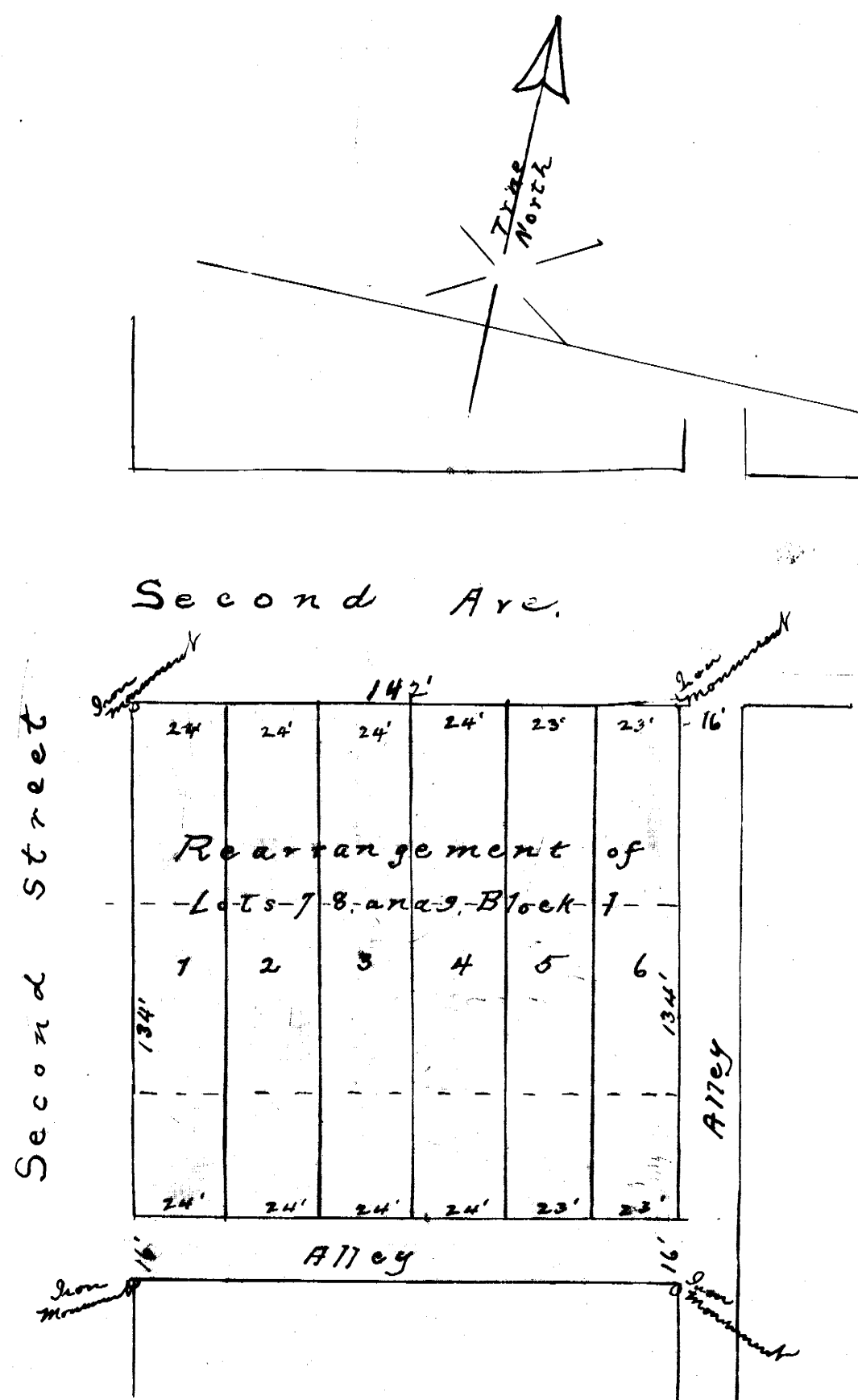


Rearrangement of
