Irish his wife the owners in fee simple of the following described premises to-wit: A part of Lot twenty four (24) of Block two (2) of the Auditor's subdivision of the North West quarter of the South West quarter of Section thirty two (32) Township one hundred nine (109) north of Range fifteen (15) West; more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point four hundred sixty eight (468) feet East and thirty (30) feet North of the southwest corner of said North West quarter of said South West quarter of Section thirty two. Thence running North along the East side of Tarbox Street four hundred thirty nine and one half (439½) feet; thence East along the South side of Jones Street one hundred twenty nine (129) feet; thence South four hundred thirty nine and one half (439½) feet; to West Walnut Street; thence West to place of beginning. do hereby certify that we have caused the said described premises to be surveyed and platted into lots, and this plat thereof to be made and good and sufficient monuments to be planted as upon this plat indicated; and the lots therein to be progressively numbered, their precise length and width to be as therein shown; and to be known as "Irish's Addition to Pine Island".

That said premises are free and clear from all incumbrances, and we hereby give and forever dedicate to and for the use and easement of the public the alley in said addition as herein represented.
