Davis his wife, the owners in fee simple of the following described premises to-wit: All that portion of the West half of the south west quarter of section twenty one (21) of Township one hundred eleven (111) north of Range fifteen (15) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, described as follows to-wit: After running five hundred fifteen (515) feet north from the south east corner of the said west half of the south west quarter of section twenty one (21) for a place of beginning; thence West four hundred ninety (490) feet; thence north thirty four and eight tenths (34 $\frac{8}{10}$ ) feet; thence East five hundred fifty two (552) feet; thence north sixty (60) feet; thence east fifty (50) feet; thence north two hundred ninety nine and seven tenths (299 $\frac{7}{10}$ ) feet; thence east thirty (30) feet; thence south six hundred fifty nine and seven tenths (659 $\frac{7}{10}$ ) feet to place of beginning.
