

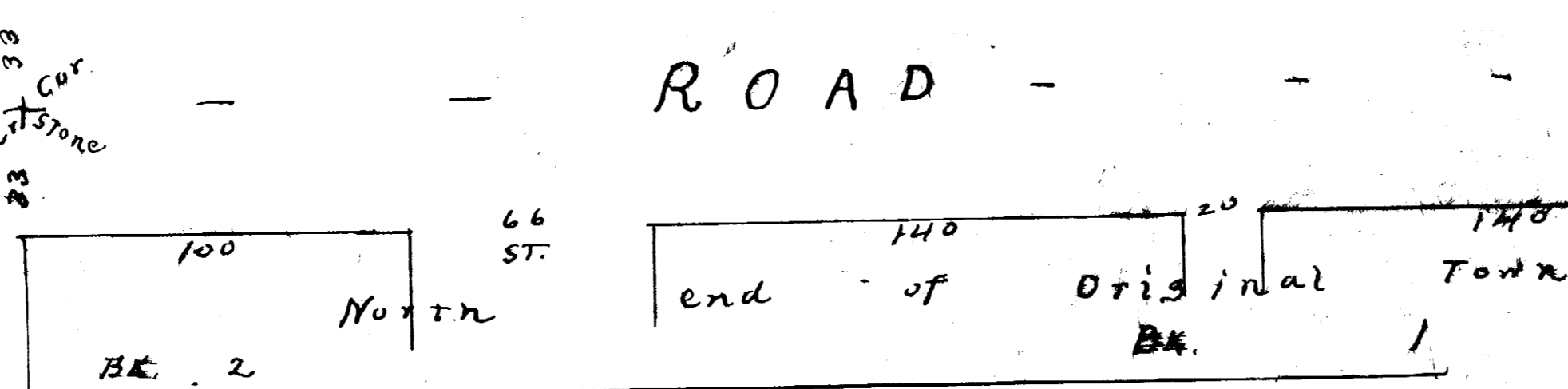

Rice, a professional Surveyor do hereby certify that on the 16th day of August, 1902, I surveyed and have now platted the Thorpe and Ferguson Addition to the Town of Dennison, and that the annexed map is a correct map of said Addition and that the lots, blocks and streets are of the dimensions as therein designated in feet and that the said Addition is more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 165 feet East and 33 feet North of the southwest corner of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 19, T. 111, R. 18 N being in the County of Goodhue, State of Minn., and running North 42.6 feet, thence West 140 feet to a point 25 feet East of the section line, thence North parallel with the section line 300 feet, thence East 346 feet, thence South 726 feet, thence West 206 feet to the place of beginning; And I further certify that I caused Stone and Iron corners to be placed on said map or plat from which future surveys should be made, viz. At the South east corner of Block 3, Stone 3x3 inches on top, and about 20 inches long; At the Southeast corner of Lot 1, Blk 3, Stone 2 x 4 inches on top, about 2 ft long; at the Northwest corner of Lot 3, Block 1, Iron pin 1/2 x 1 1/2 inches, 3/4 ft long; at the Northeast corner of Lot 3, Block 2, Iron pin 1 x 1 inches, abt 2 ft long; At the Northwest corner of Lot 3, Blk 2, 3/4 inch Iron bolt, 2 ft long.
