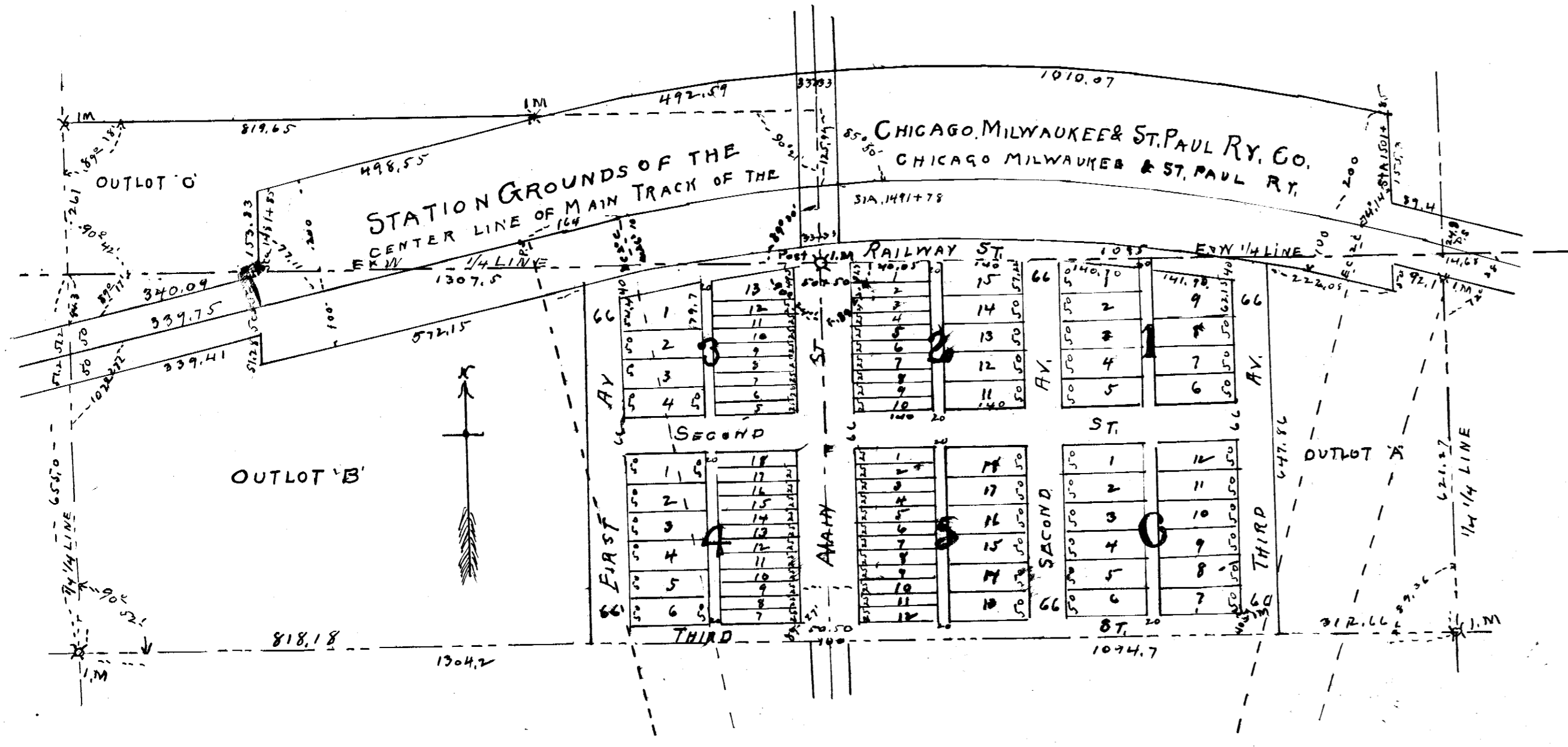


WANAMINGO

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the MILWAUKEE LAND COMPANY, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Iowa, owner of the tract of land described as follows to wit: All those parts of the N. 1/4, N. 1/4, S. 1/4, S. 1/4 Section thirty (30) Township one hundred ten (110) North Range fifteen (15) East and of the SW 1/4, NW 1/4 of Section one hundred ten (110) North also all the NW 1/4, SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section thirty (30) Township one hundred ten (110) North Range fifteen (15) East and the South two hundred sixty one (61) feet of the SE 1/4, NE 1/4 of said Section except so much of the same track as is included in the Right of Way and Station Grounds of the Chicago, Milwaukee and St. Paul Railway has caused to be placed as the Townsite of Wanamingo" as shown by this plat, and that Milwaukee Land Company now having decided and grants to the holder the use forever of all the streets, avenues and alleys as shown upon said plat.
