

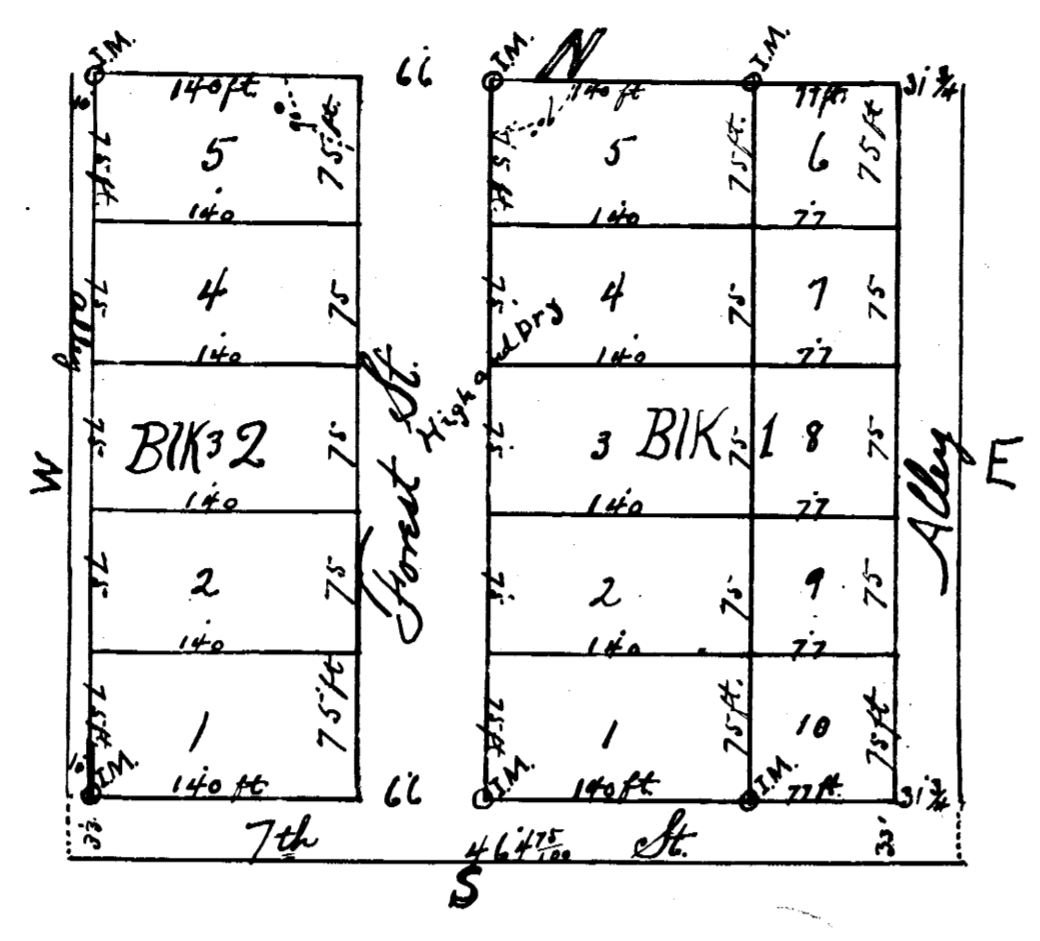

I, C. A. Reed, a practical surveyor, do hereby certify that in
the month of September, A. D. 1910, that I made a survey
of H. H. Hewitt's 1st addition to Kenyon, Minn. situated
in the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of sect. 9,
Town 109 north, Range 18 West, and is more particularly described
as follows to-wit: Beginning at a point on the proposed
east line of Forest St. 66 ft. south of the south-west corner
of lot 1, S. A. Rullier's 2nd addition to Kenyon, thence
running west 216 ft. thence south 408 ft. thence east
464^{1/2} ft. thence north 408 ft. thence west 248^{1/2} ft.
to the place of beginning, and that the plat herein
is a correct representation of the survey thereof,
that all distances are correctly shown on said plat,
that the monuments for guidance of future
