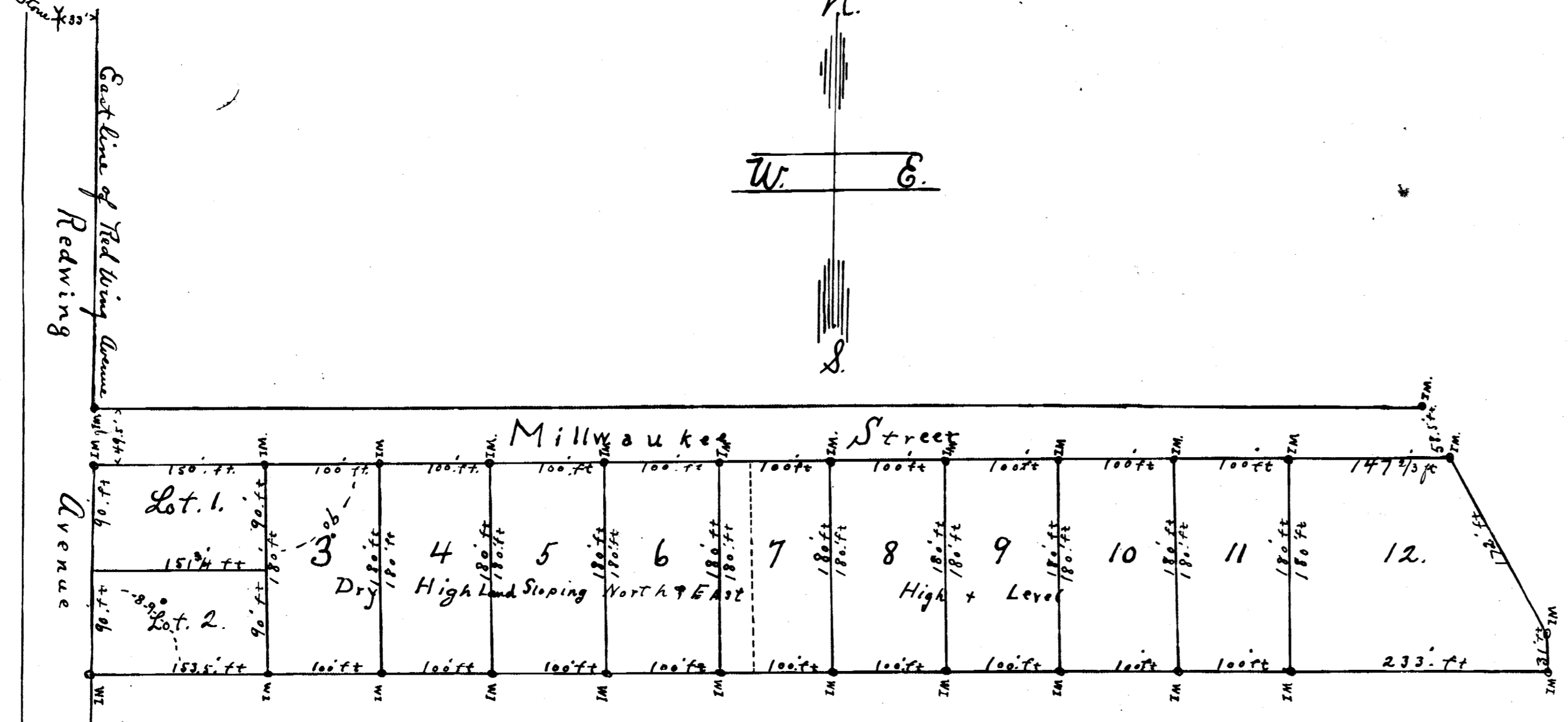

W. J. GOODFELLOW'S ADDITION TO KENYON Goodhue County, Minn.

Vacating this Plat in
Book No. 311, P. Page 319



I, C. A. Reed, a practical surveyor do hereby certify that in the month of March A.D. 1911, I made a survey of W. J. Goodfellow's addition to Kenyon Goodhue County Minnesota and that the above plat is a true and correct plat thereof. That I have placed iron monuments in the ground as indicated on plat as I.M. from which future surveys can be made. The outside boundary lines are correctly designated on the plat and that the topography is correctly shown on said plat there are no wet lands or public highways to be designated on said plat, a full and correct description of lands as plotted is as follows to-wit: Beginning at a point on the East line of Red Wing Avenue thirty three feet (33') East and three hundred and fifty feet (350') South of the North West corner of the East one half of the North East quarter of Section Nine (9) Town one hundred and Nine (09) North and Range eighteen (18) West, thence running East seven hundred and eight seven (1167') parallel with the North line of Section to the West line of the right of way of the Chicago Great Western Railway, thence South easterly along said right of way two hundred and thirty and five tenths feet (230.5') to the section line between Section Nine (9) and ten (10) thence South on section line thirty one feet (31'), thence West twelve hundred and eighty six and five tenths (1286.5') to the East line of Red Wing Avenue, thence North on East line of said Avenue two hundred and twenty nine and five tenths feet (229.5') to the place of beginning. I further certify that the size of lots and width of street are as designated on plat, and that no river, creek or wet lands exist or have existed on said described lands.

Goodfellow and Rose Goodfellow his wife the owners and proprietors of the following described land to-wit: Beginning at a point on the East line of Red Wing Avenue thirty three feet (33') East and three hundred and fifty feet (350') South of the North West corner of the East one half of the North East quarter of Section Nine (9) Town one hundred and Nine (09) North and Range eighteen (18) West, thence running East seven hundred and eight seven (1167') parallel with the North line of Section to the West line of the right of way of the Chicago Great Western Railway, thence South easterly along said right of way two hundred and thirty and five tenths feet (230.5') to the section line between Section Nine (9) and ten (10) thence South on section line thirty one feet (31'), thence West twelve hundred and eighty six and five tenths (1286.5') to the East line of Red Wing Avenue, thence North on East line of said Avenue two hundred and twenty nine and five tenths (229.5') feet to the place of beginning.

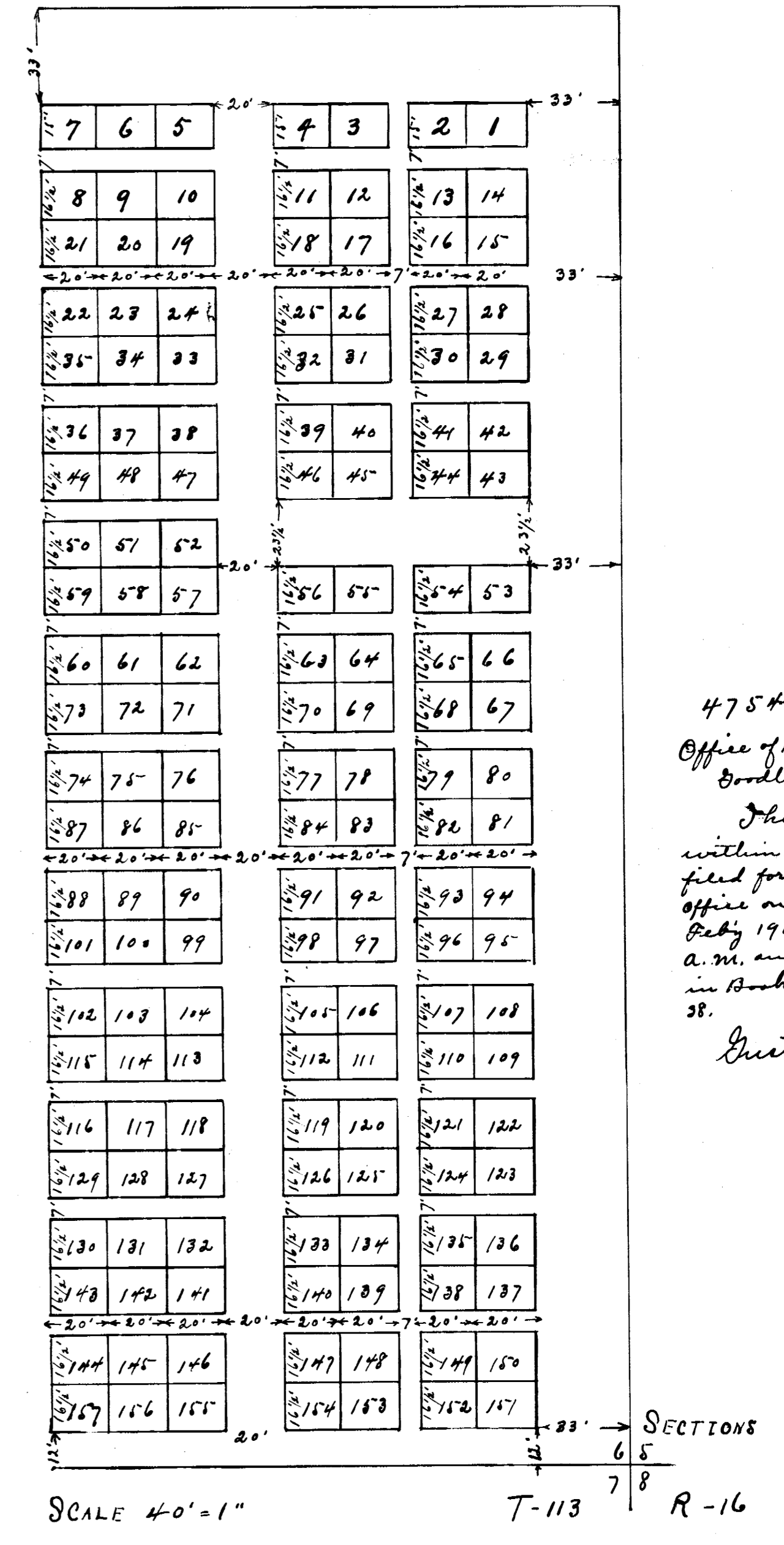
