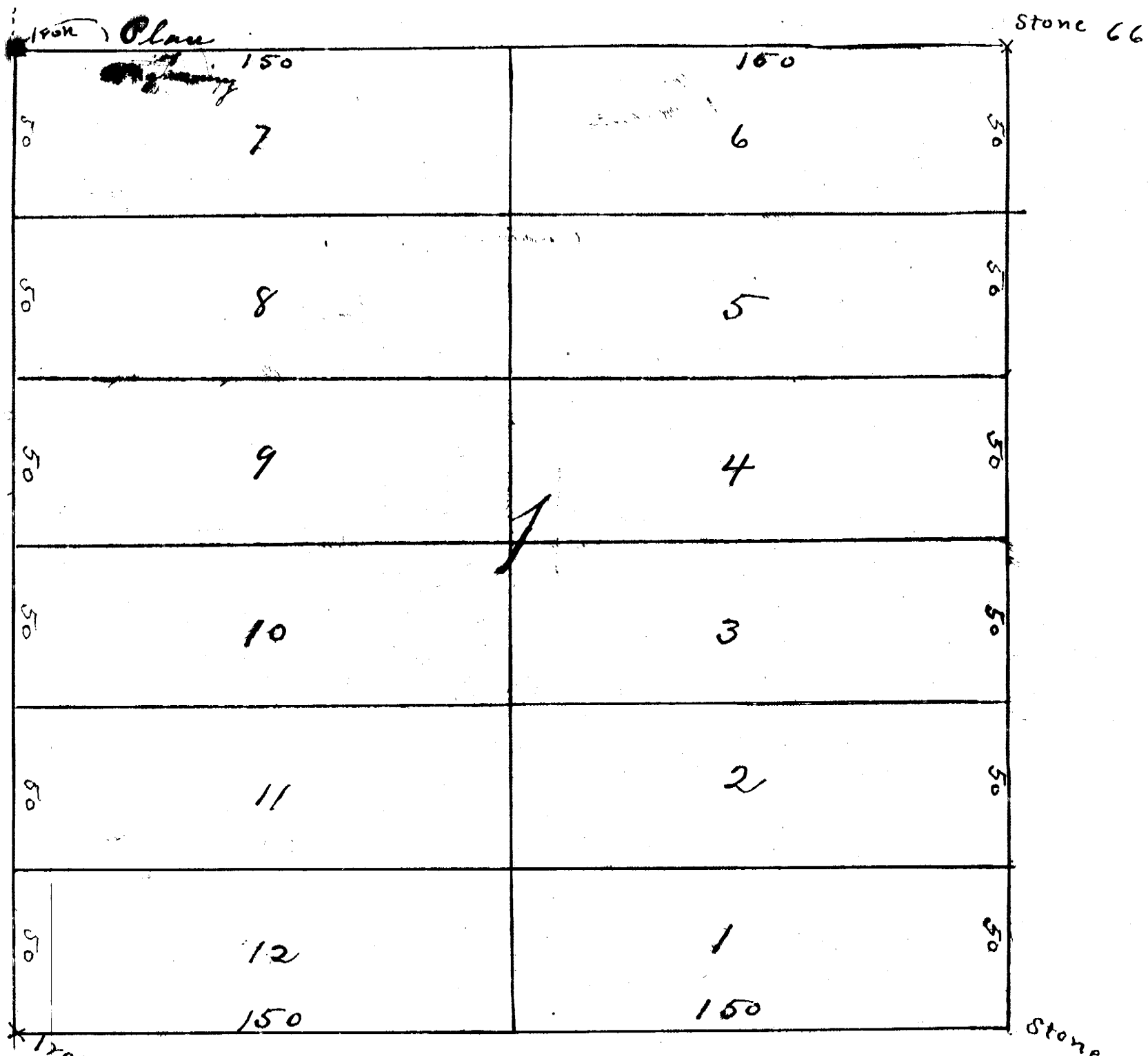
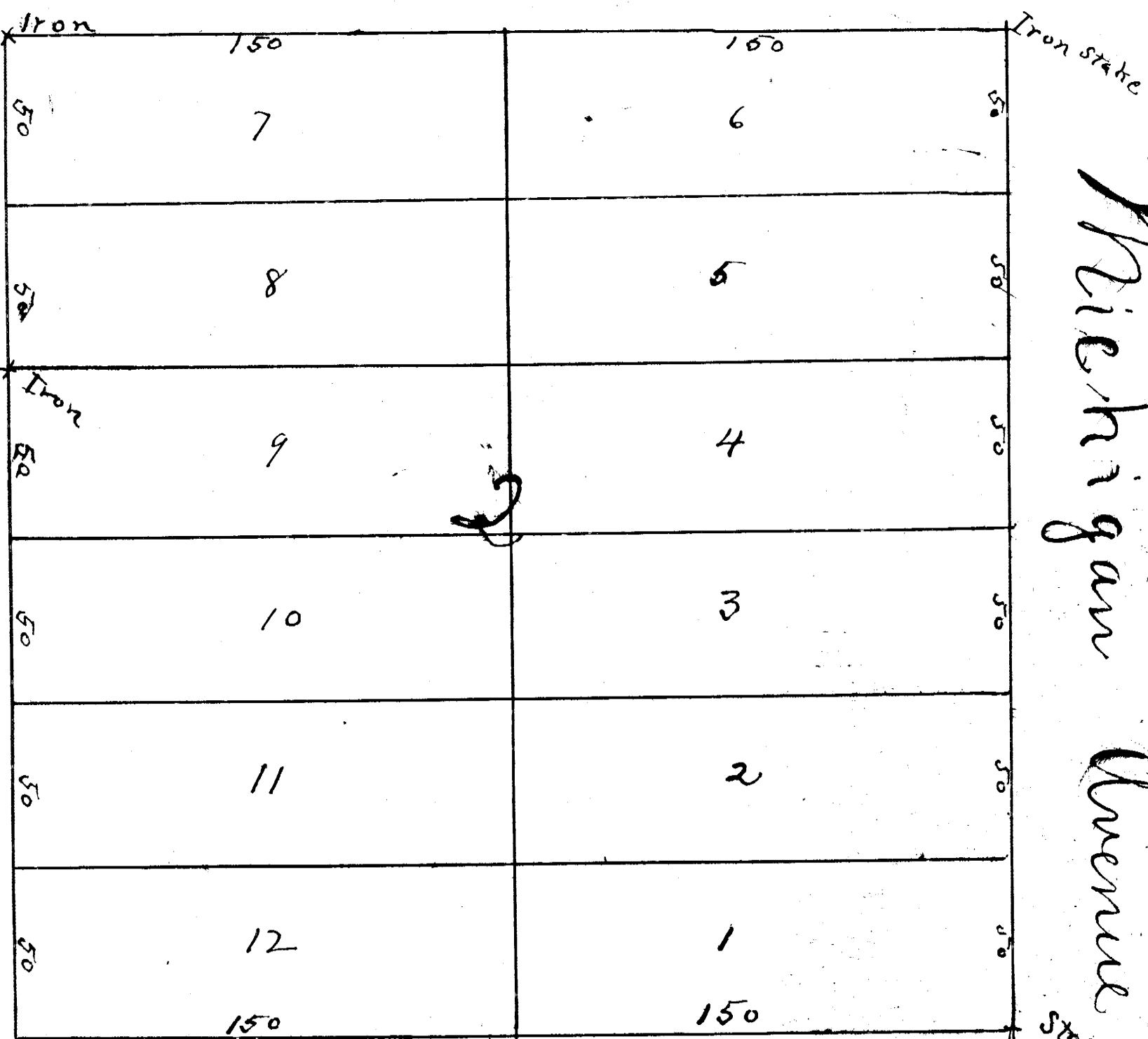


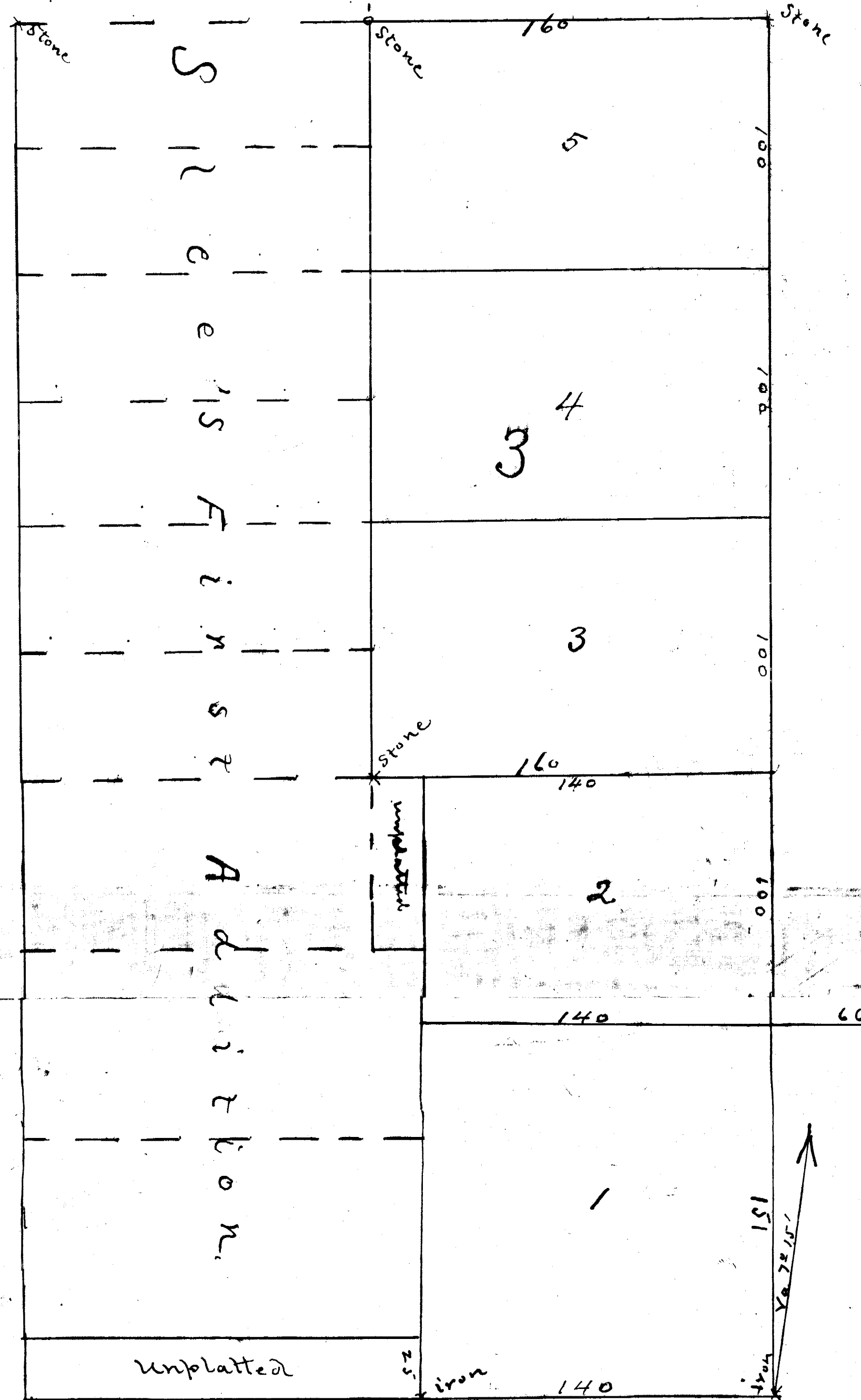

I, F. O. Rice a practical Surveyor, do hereby certify that on the 21st and 22nd days of April, 1905 I surveyed and have now plotted Slee's Second Addition to the Town of Dennison, and that the annexed map is a correct map of said Addition and the lots, Blocks and Streets are of the dimensions as therein designated in feet, and that the said Addition is more particularly described as follows: To wit: Beginning at a point 30 feet south and 532 feet East of the N.W. corner of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 19, T. 111. N. of R. 15. W., being in Goodhue County, Minn. and running East 366 feet, thence South 1192 feet, thence West 66 feet, thence South 151 feet, thence West 140 feet, thence North 251 feet, thence West 20 feet, thence North 366 feet, thence West 140 feet, to the east line of Thorpe Street, thence North along the east line of Thorpe Street 666 feet to the place of beginning. And I further certify that I caused stone and iron corners to be placed as designated on said map, a plot from which future surveys should be made, viz: Stone at the N.E. and S.E. corners of Block 1, Stone at the N.W. and S.W. corners of Block 1, Stone at the S.E. corner of Block 2, Stone at the N.W. corner of Block 2 and at the S.W. corner of Block 2, Stone at the N.E. and N.W. corners of Block 3 and at the S.W. corner of Block 3, and iron at the S.E. and S.W. corners of Block 3. (There is also a stone at the N.W. corner of Slee's first addition to Dennison.)
