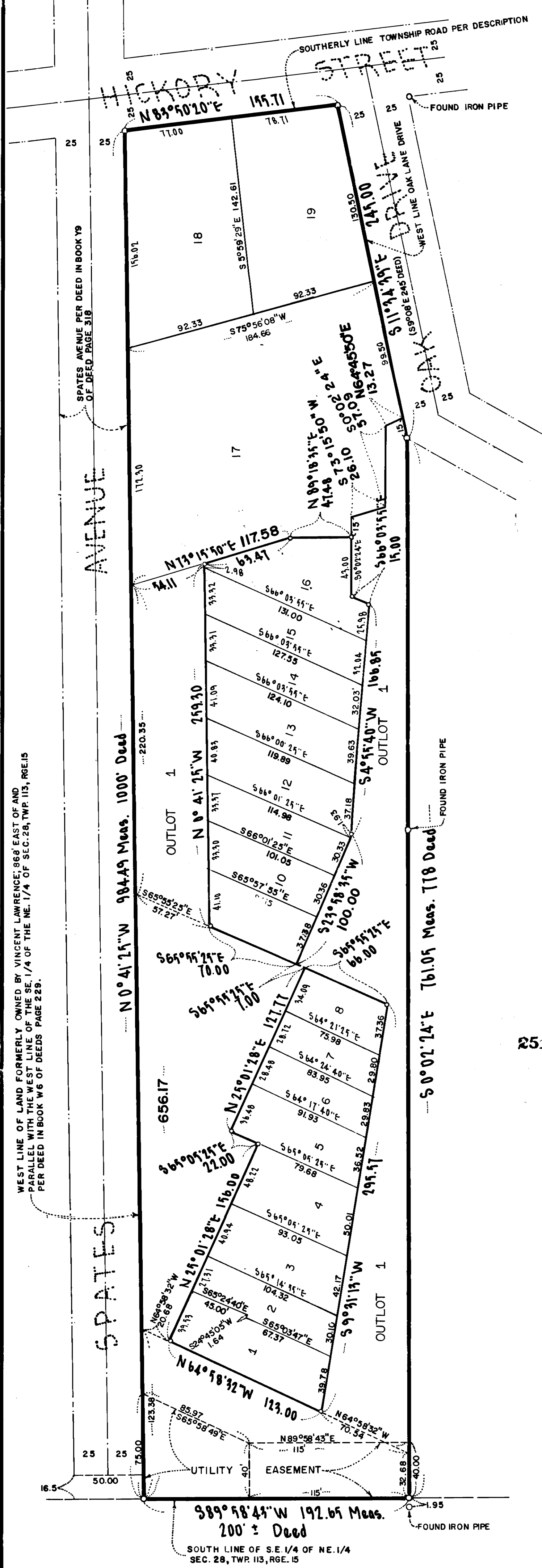


# WILSON'S OAKWOOD ADDITION TO RED WING



KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Wilfred R. Wilson and Margaret E. Wilson, husband and wife, owners and proprietors, and Goodhue County National Bank, A United States Corporation, mortgagee, of the following described property to wit:

All that part of the southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section 28, in township 113 north, of range 15 west of the fifth principal meridian, in the County of Goodhue and State of Minnesota, described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the west line of Oak Lane Drive with the southerly line of the Township Road; running thence south 9 degrees 08 minutes east along the westerly line of Oak Lane Drive for 245 feet, thence due south 778 feet to the south line of said southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), thence west 200 feet, more or less, to the west line of the Vincent Lawrence land, thence north 1000 feet to the southerly line of said Township Road, thence easterly along the southerly line of said Township Road to the place of beginning.

Have caused the same to be surveyed and platted as WILSON'S OAKWOOD ADDITION TO RED WING, and do hereby donate and dedicate to the public for public use forever the utility easement as shown on the plat.

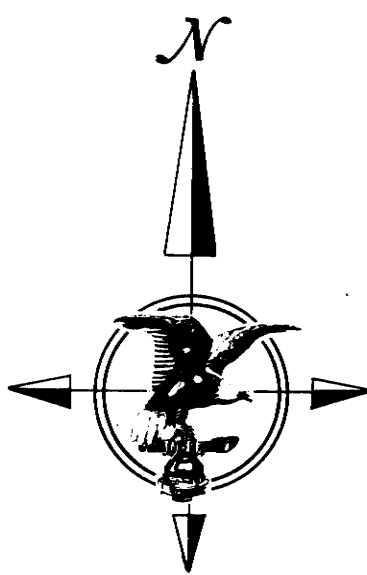
