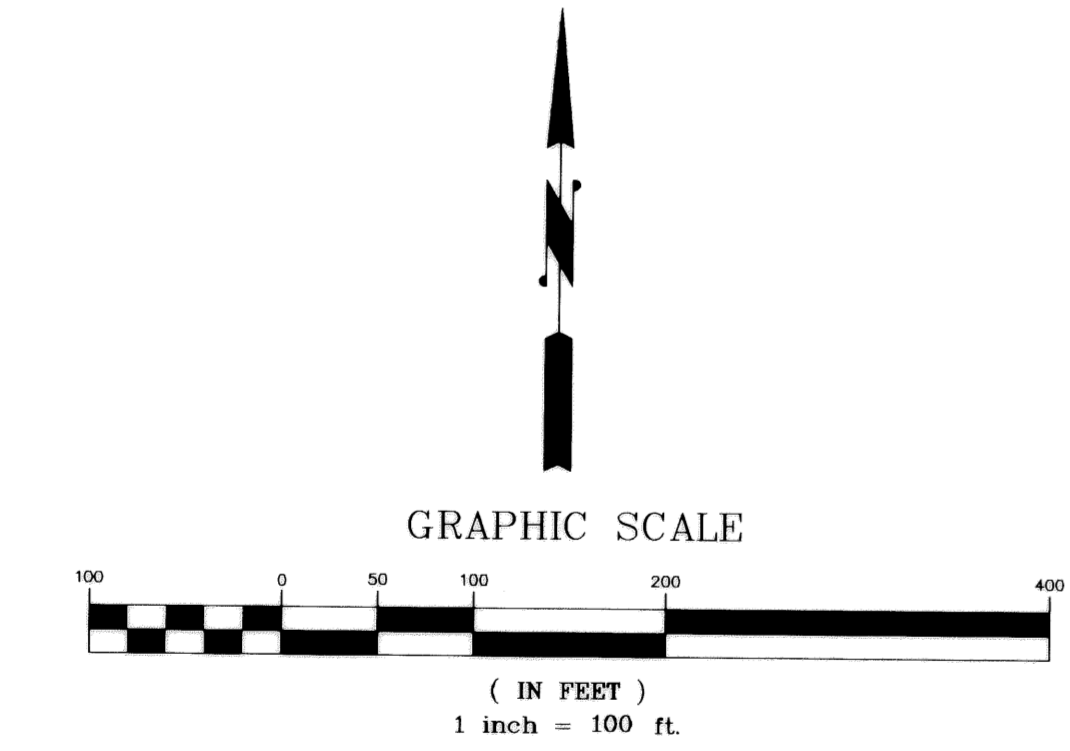
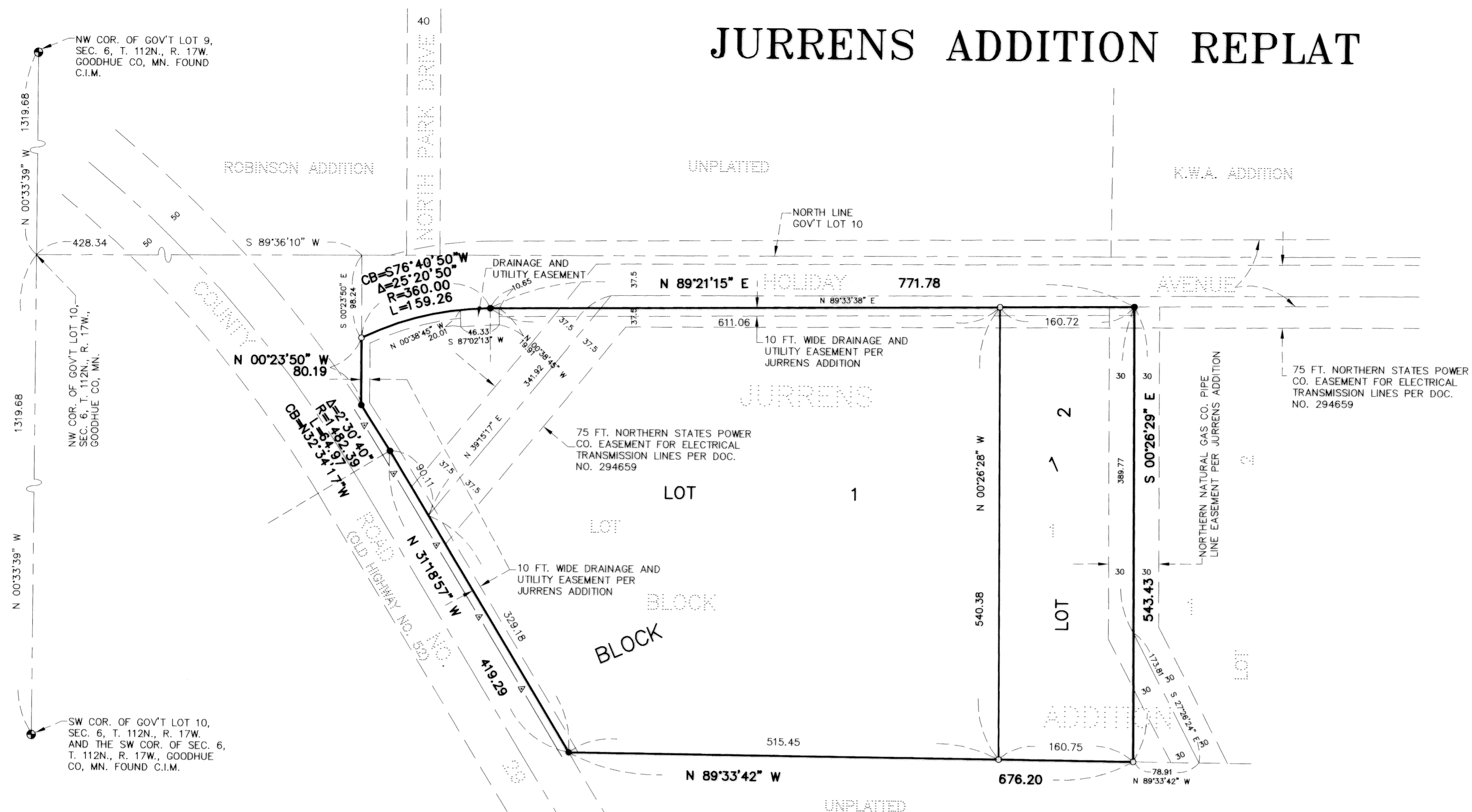
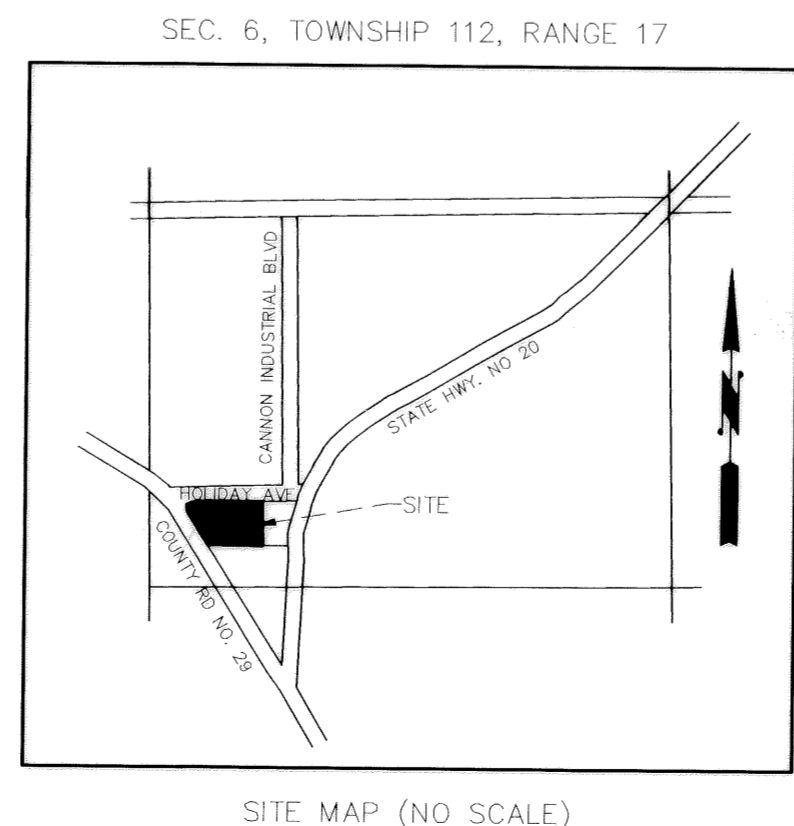


JURRENS ADDITION REPLAT

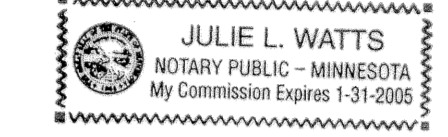

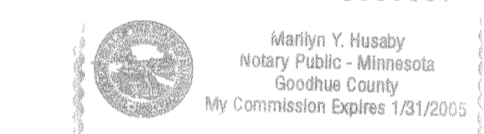
