

UNION SECOND ADDITION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That St. Mary's Church of Belvidere, Minnesota, a religious corporation organized under Mn. State statute 315, owner and proprietor, of the following described property to wit:

That part of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 32, Township 111 North, Range 14 West, Goodhue County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Commencing at the southeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 32; thence on an assumed bearing of North, along the east line of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 32, a distance of 365.50 feet to the easterly extension of the southerly line of UNION ADDITION, according to the plat thereof filed in the Goodhue County Recorder's Office; thence South 89 degrees 37 minutes 00 seconds West, along said easterly extension, along the south line of UNION ADDITION, a distance of 373.00 feet to the southwest corner of said UNION ADDITION; thence northerly, along the west line of said UNION ADDITION, a distance of 185.01 feet to the point of beginning of the land to be described; thence South 89 degrees 37 minutes 00 seconds West, parallel with said south line of UNION ADDITION, a distance of 140.85 feet; thence North 00 degrees 48 minutes 34 seconds West, a distance of 795.16 feet to the north line of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 32; thence North 89 degrees 48 minutes 06 seconds East, along said north line, a distance of 129.61 feet to the northwest corner of said UNION ADDITION; thence southerly, along the west line of said UNION ADDITION, a distance of 794.91 feet to the point of beginning.

Have caused the same to be surveyed and platted as UNION SECOND ADDITION, and do hereby donate and dedicate to the public, for public use forever the thoroughfares and also dedicating the easements as shown on the plat for drainage and utility purposes only.

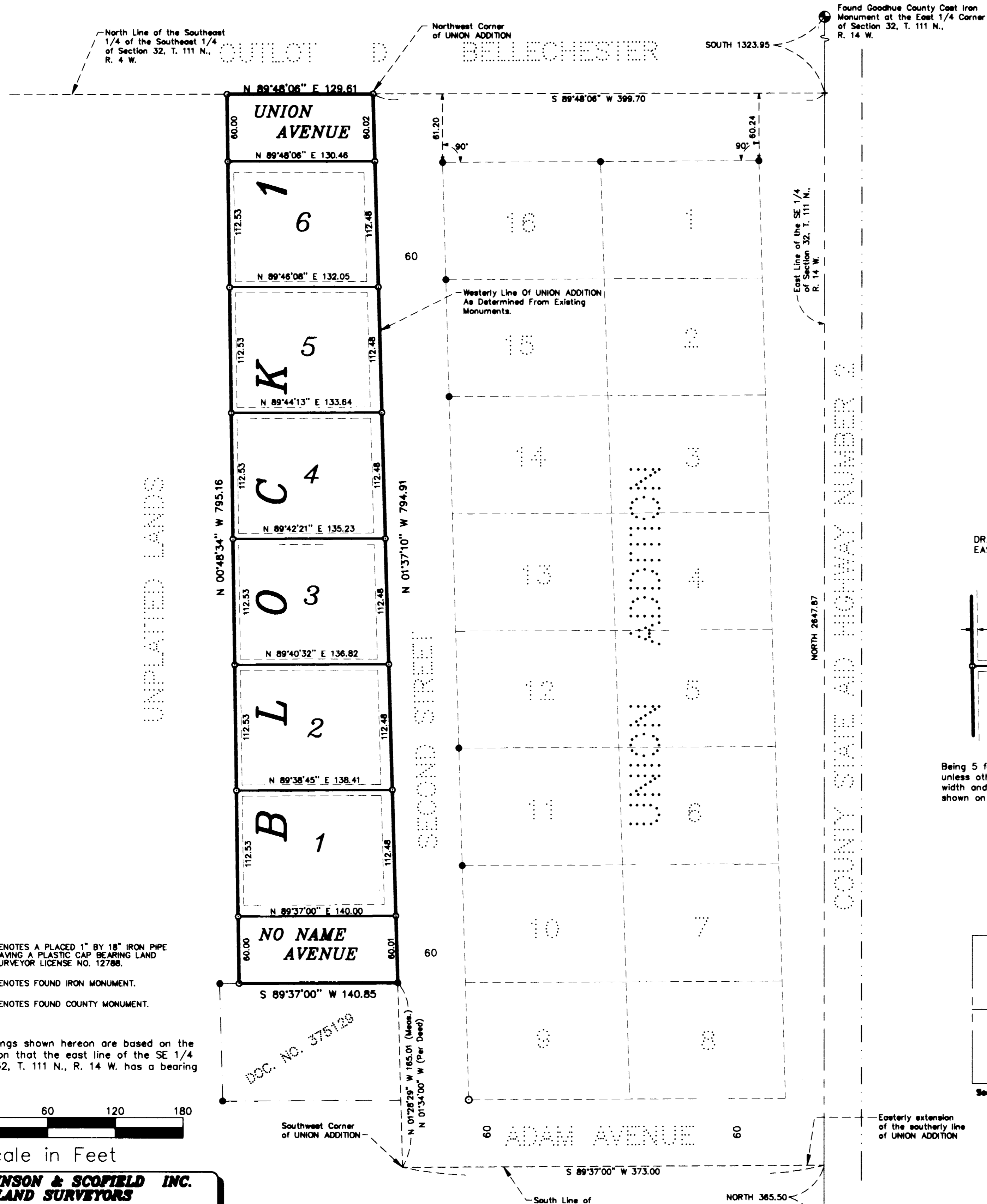

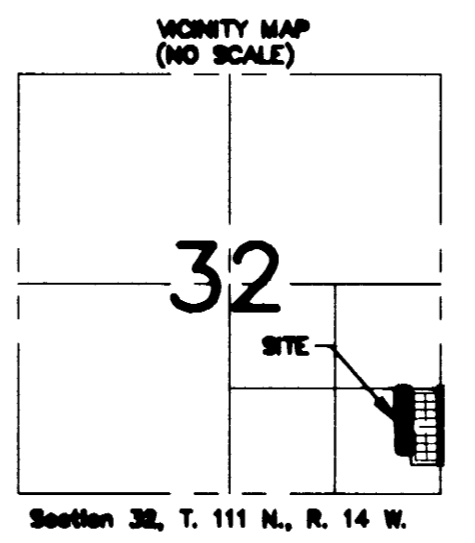

DRAINAGE AND UTILITY EASEMENTS ARE SHOWN THUS:

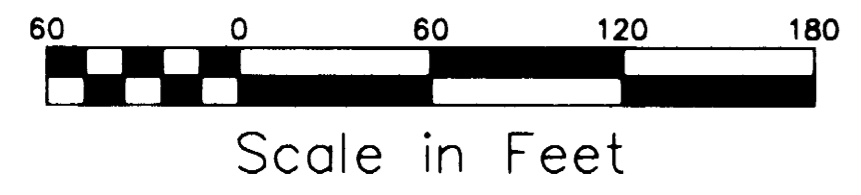


Being 5 feet in width and adjoining side lot lines, unless otherwise indicated, and 10 feet in width and adjoining street lines, as shown on the plat.
