

BRINGGOLD ADDITION

KNOW ALL PERSONS BY THESE PRESENTS: That THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK IN CANNON FALLS, a national banking association, owners and proprietors of the following described property to wit:
That part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 26, Township 113 North, Range 15 West, Goodhue County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Commencing at the southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 26; thence South 88 degrees 39 minutes 47 seconds West, assumed bearing, along the south line of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 26, a distance of 83.61 feet to the point of beginning of the land to be described; thence North 88 degrees 39 minutes 47 seconds East, along the south line of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 26, a distance of 438.27 feet; thence North 01 degree 20 minutes 13 seconds West, a distance of 438.87 feet to the southerly right of way line of State Highway Number 61, as established in that certain order filed in Book 89 of M.R., page 192 Goodhue County Recorder's Office, being a line parallel with and distant 175.00 feet southerly, as measured at a right angle, of the centerline of the northbound lane of State Highway Number 61, as now located and established; thence North 86 degrees 07 minutes 09 seconds West, along said southerly right of way line, parallel with said centerline of the northbound lane, a distance of 352.55 feet, to the west line of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 26; thence South 00 degrees 54 minutes 05 seconds East, along said west line, a distance of 15.05 feet to said southerly right of way line of State Highway Number 61, parallel with said centerline of the northbound lane, a distance of 190.00 feet southerly, as measured at a right angle, of said centerline of the northbound lane of State Highway Number 61; thence North 86 degrees 07 minutes 09 seconds West, along said southerly right of way line, parallel with said centerline of the northbound lane, a distance of 13.34 feet; thence westerly, along said southerly right of way line, parallel with said centerline of the northbound lane, along a spiral curve concave to the north, which has a chord bearing of North 86 degrees 04 minutes 18 seconds West, a distance of 50.91 feet to the intersection with a line parallel with and distant 20.00 feet east, as measured at a right angle, of the east line of Park Avenue, as surveyed and established in the plat of HOMELAND ADDITION, filed in the Goodhue County Recorder's Office; thence South 00 degrees 55 minutes 11 seconds East, parallel with said east line of Park Avenue, a distance of 423.87 feet to the intersection with the easterly extension of the southerly line of State Street, as surveyed and established in said plat of HOMELAND ADDITION; thence North 88 degrees 30 minutes 04 seconds West, along said extension, a distance of 20.02 feet to said east line of Park Avenue; thence South 01 degree 20 minutes 13 seconds East, a distance of 36.89 feet to the point of beginning.

Has caused the same to be surveyed and platted as BRINGGOLD ADDITION and does hereby dedicate to the public for public use forever the thoroughfares, and also dedicating the easements as shown on this plat for drainage and utility purposes only.

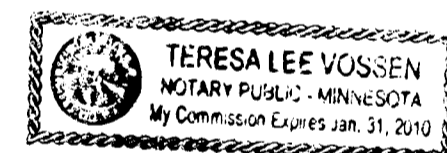

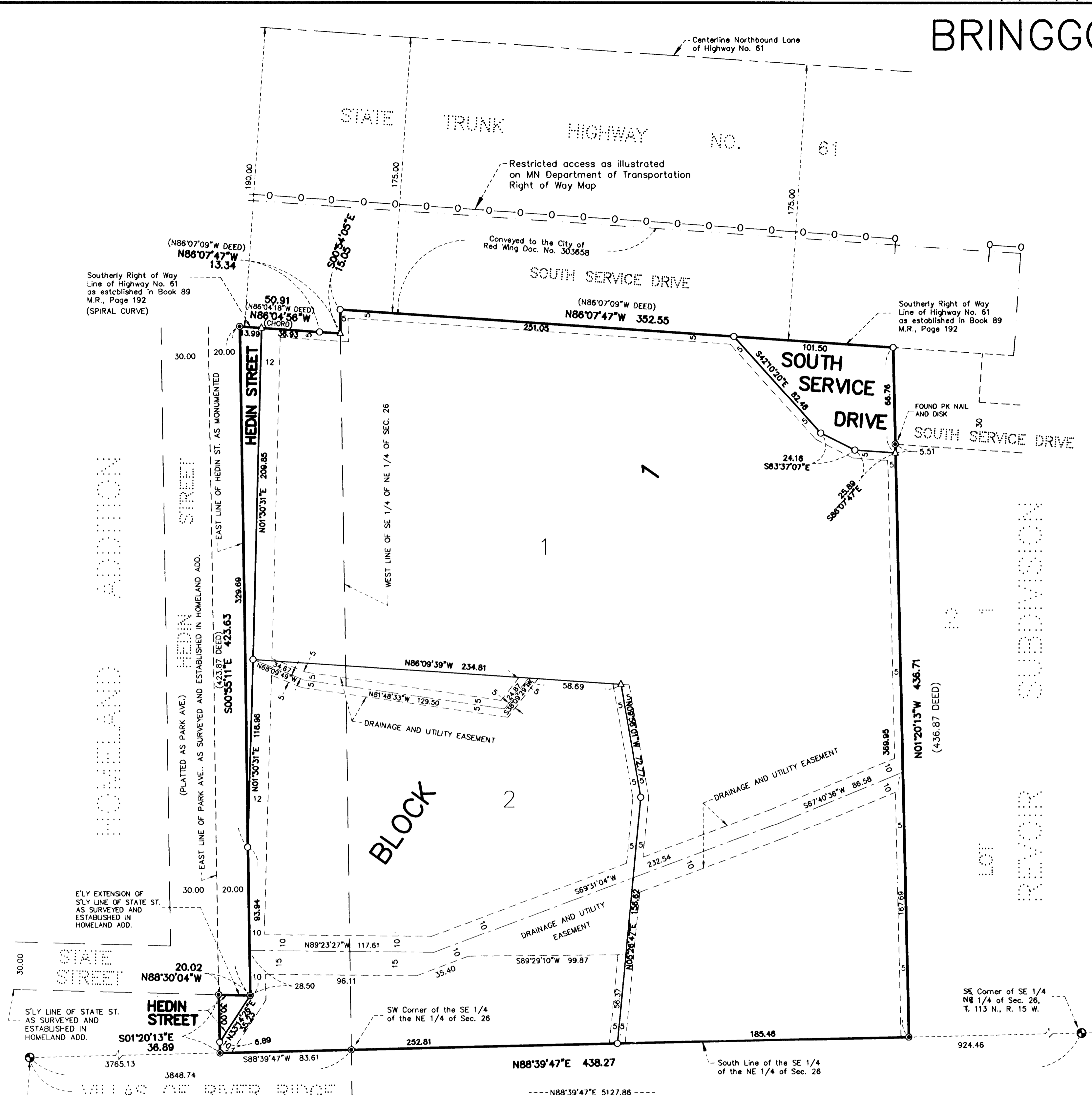

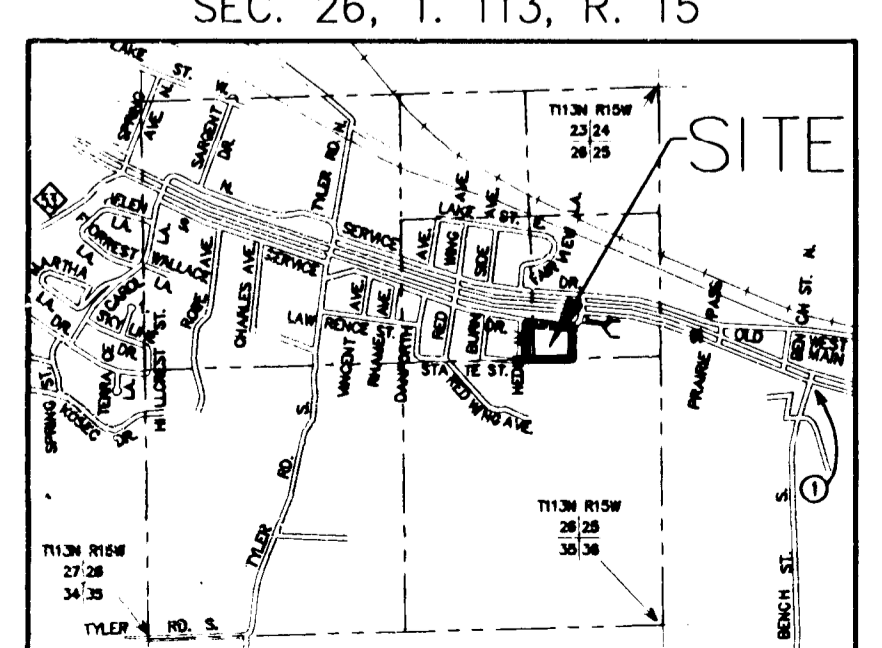
