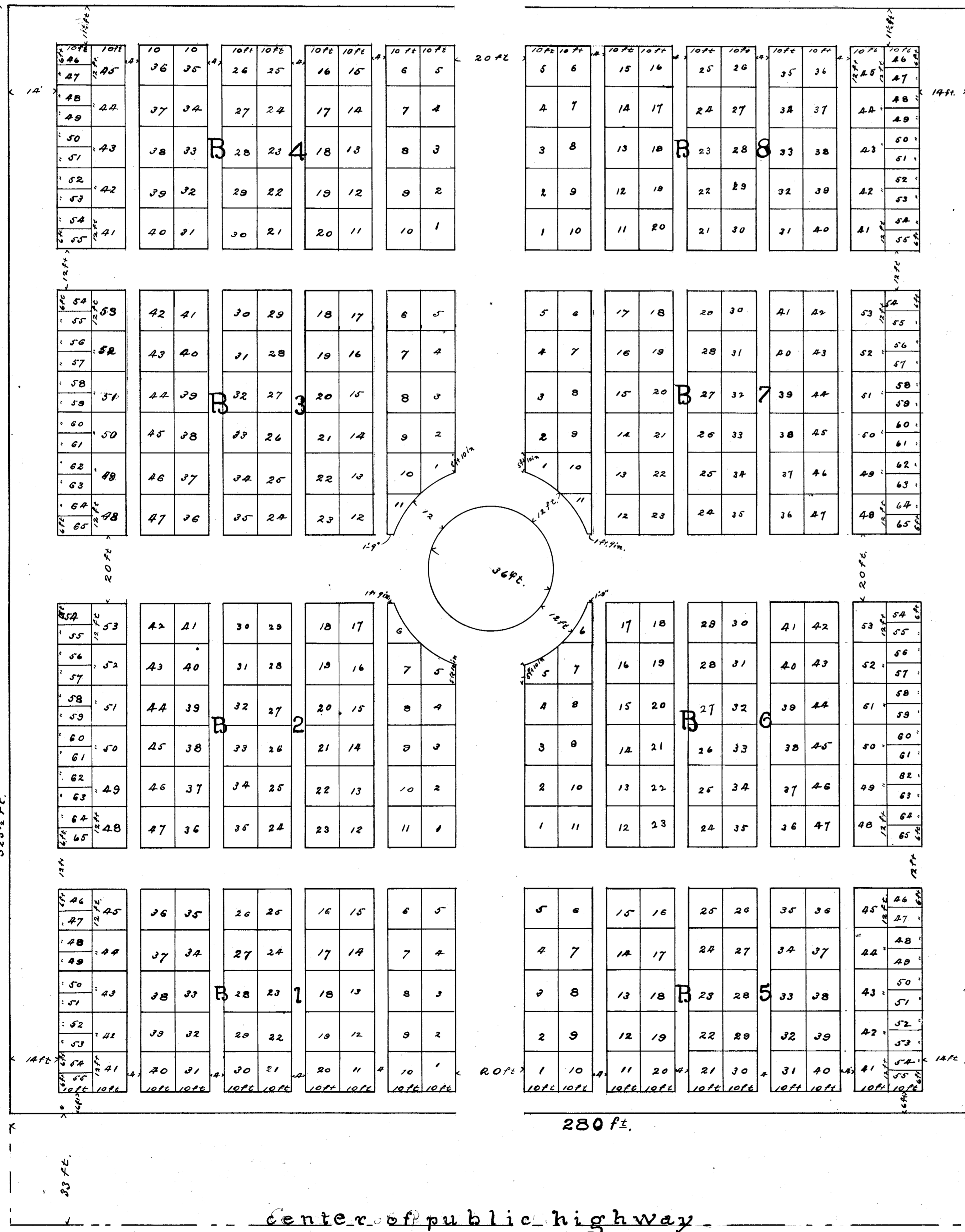


EVERGREEN CEMETERY

 Section Twenty one of Township one hundred eleven North, of Range fifteen West,
 described as follows: Beginning at the south west corner of said section, twenty one,
 running thence east two hundred eighty feet thence north three hundred fifty eight and
 one half (358½) feet thence west two hundred eighty (280) feet, thence south to
 place of beginning. do hereby certify that we have caused the said
