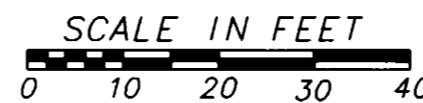
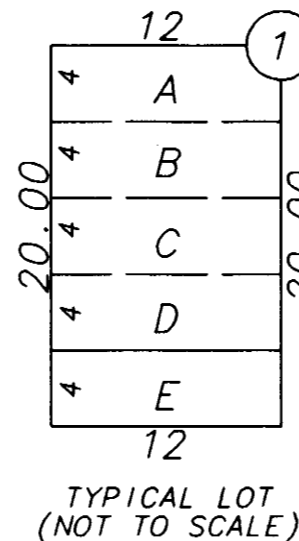
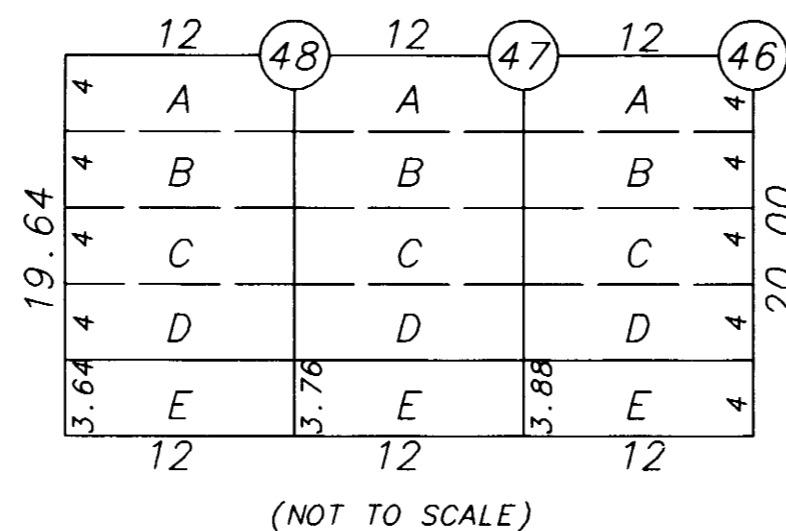
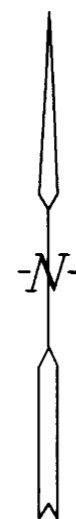
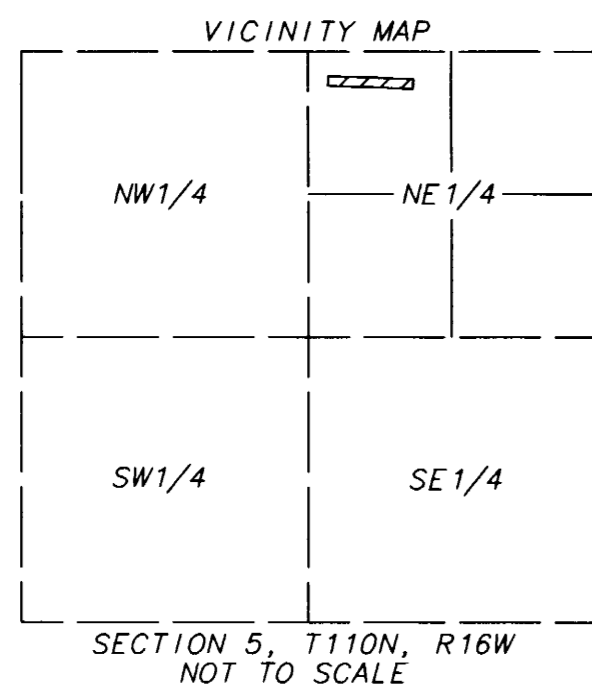


MINNEOLA CEMETERY SECOND ADDITION

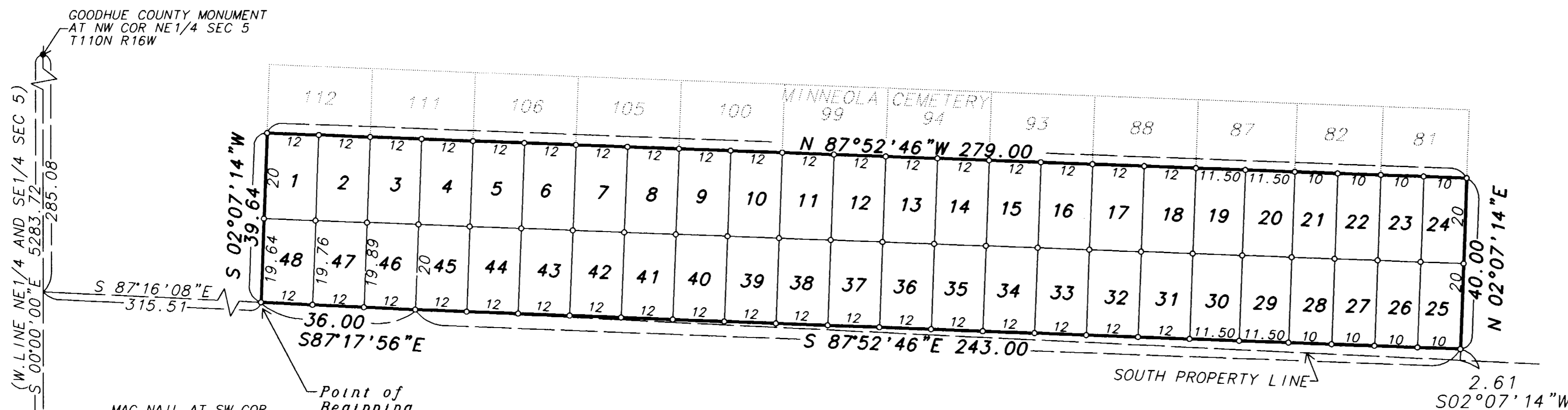
