

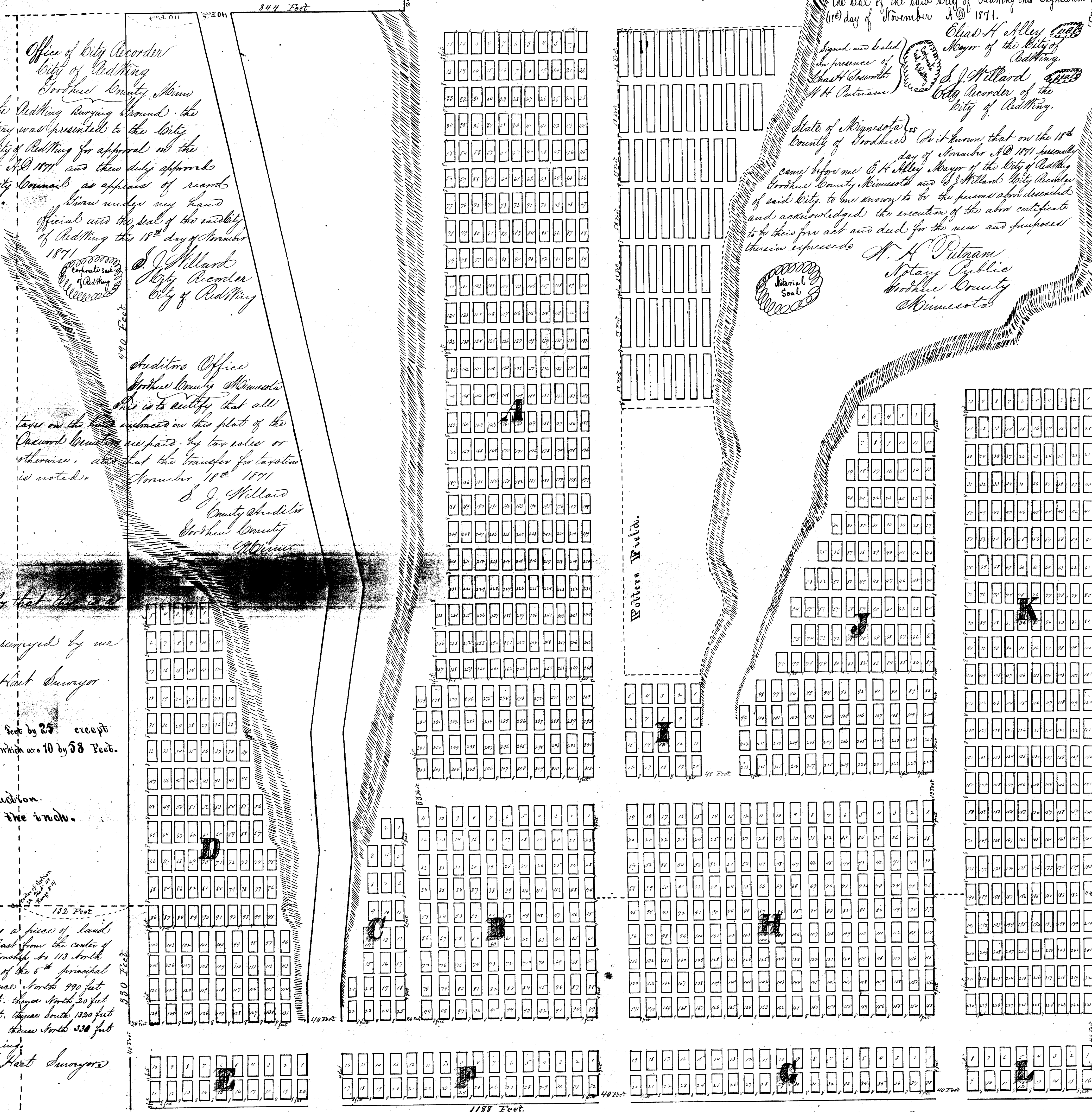
Know all men by these presents, that the undersigned O. H. Alley Mayor of the City of Red Wing in Goodhue County State of Minnesota do by virtue of the power and authority upon us conferred by the City Council of said City of Red Wing at a meeting of said City Council held at the Council Rooms the 9<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1871. hereby certify that the said City of Red Wing through its proper authority has caused to be laid out, and that we do hereby for and in the name and behalf of the said City of Red Wing dedicate for a Public Cemetery the land described in the Surveyors Certificate hereon, and do hereby give and dedicate all lots, blocks, streets and alleys designated on this Plat for Cemetery purposes upon such conditions and subject to such rules and regulations as now are or hereafter may be lawfully ordained by the said City Council of the City of Red Wing to be held used and occupied exclusively for a Cemetery for the burial of the dead, and to be known as Oakwood Cemetery.

In witness whereof we the undersigned by virtue of the authority conferred as aforesaid have hereunto set our hands officially and seals and
