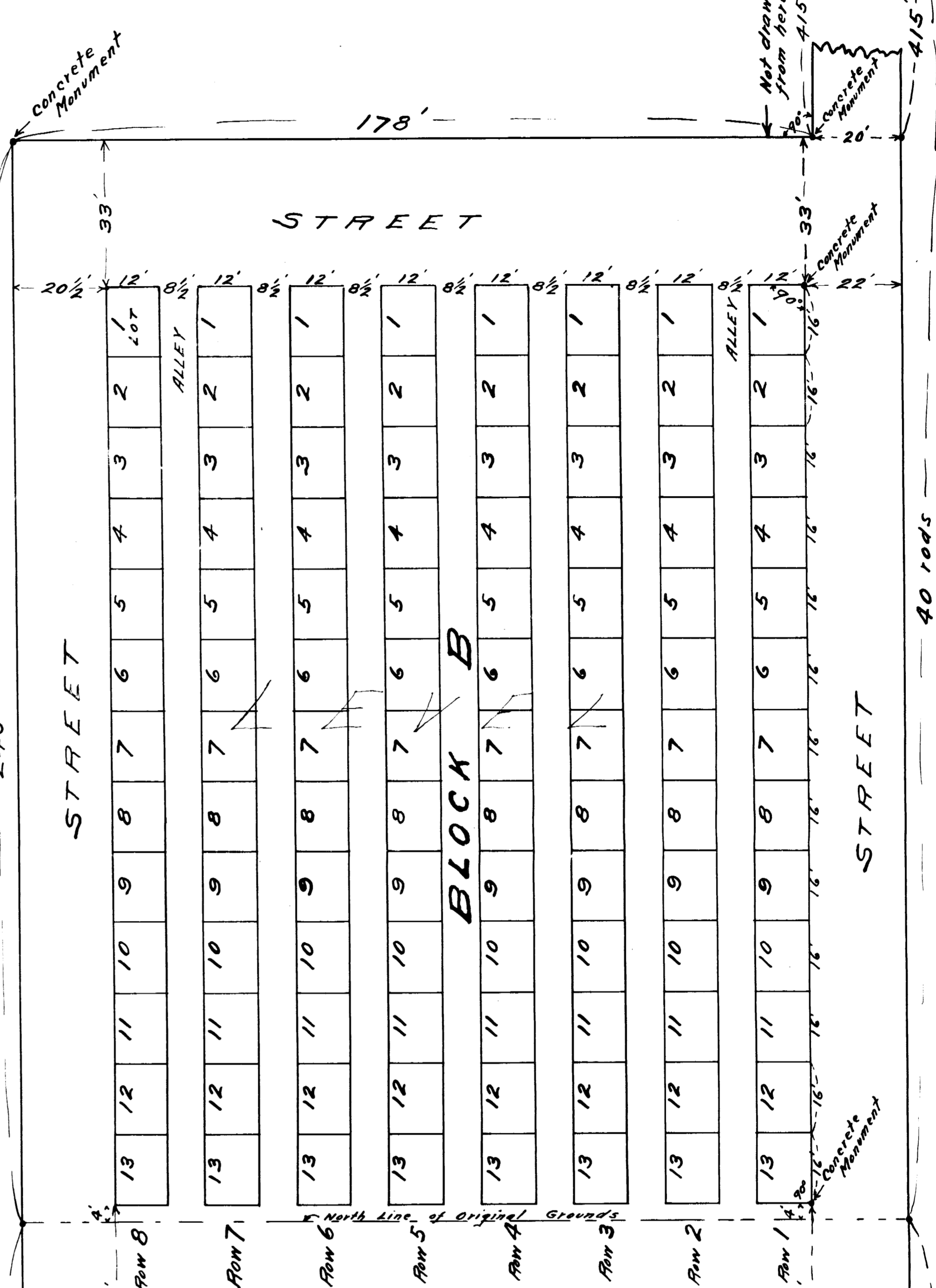


Center Line of ST. PAUL HIGHWAY

 "The Congregation of the United Lutheran Church of Zumbrota, Minnesota", a Corporation of the County of Goodhue and State of Minnesota, is the owner in fee-simple of the following described real estate in the County of Goodhue and State of Minnesota, as follows: Commencing at a point Two Hundred Twenty Eight (228) rods South from the North-East corner of the North-West quarter (N.W. 1/4) of Section Twenty Five (25) in Township One Hundred Ten (110) North, Range Sixteen (16) West, in the center of the St. Paul Highway, so called; running thence West Twenty (20) Feet; Thence running South Four Hundred Fifteen (415) Feet; Thence West One Hundred Seventy Eight (178) Feet; Thence South Seven Hundred Seven (707) Feet to Northern Line of C. M. & St. P. Railway; Thence South-Easterly along said Northern right of way line of Railway Two Hundred Eight (208) Feet to the North and South center line of said Section Twenty Five (25); Thence North Seventy-Two (72) rods to the Place of Beginning. Said tract containing Three and half acres, more or less.  
 I do hereby declare that it has caused said premises to be surveyed and platted and monuments fixed as designated on plat by Albert E.
