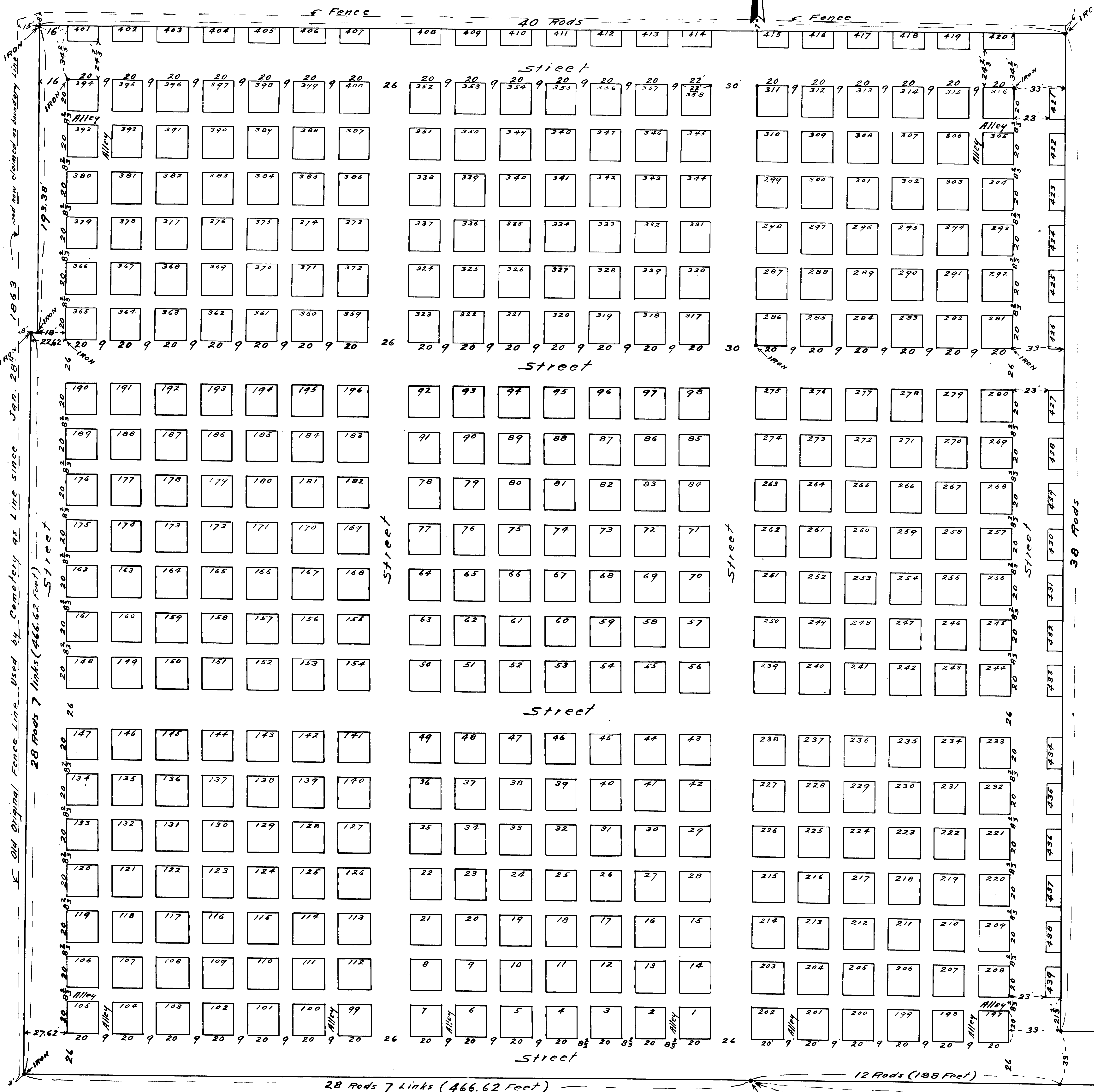

Know all men by these presents, that the "Zumbrota Cemetery Association" of the County of Goodhue and State of Minnesota, the owners in fee-simple of the following Real Estate: All that part of the North-East Quarter of Section Twenty-Five, Township One Hundred Ten North, Range Sixteen West (Sec. 25, T. 110 N., R. 16 W.), in Goodhue County and State of Minnesota, described as follows: Commencing at the South East corner of the South West Quarter of the North East Quarter (S.W. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4) of said Section Twenty-Five for Place of Beginning; Thence run East Twelve (12) rods; Thence North Forty (40) rods; Thence West Forty (40) rods; Thence South One Hundred Ninety Three (193) Feet; Thence South Twenty-Eight (28) rods and Seven (7) links to Quarter Section line; Thence Twenty-Eight (28) rods and Seven (7) links to Place of Beginning. Said tract containing just a trifle over Ten (10) acres. Also the South Two (2) rods of the South East Quarter of the North East Quarter (S.E. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4) of said Section Twenty-Five (25) for a Public Road from East side of above described Cemetery property to the East side of said South East Quarter of North East Quarter to main Public Highway.
